

Bedsread Attendance

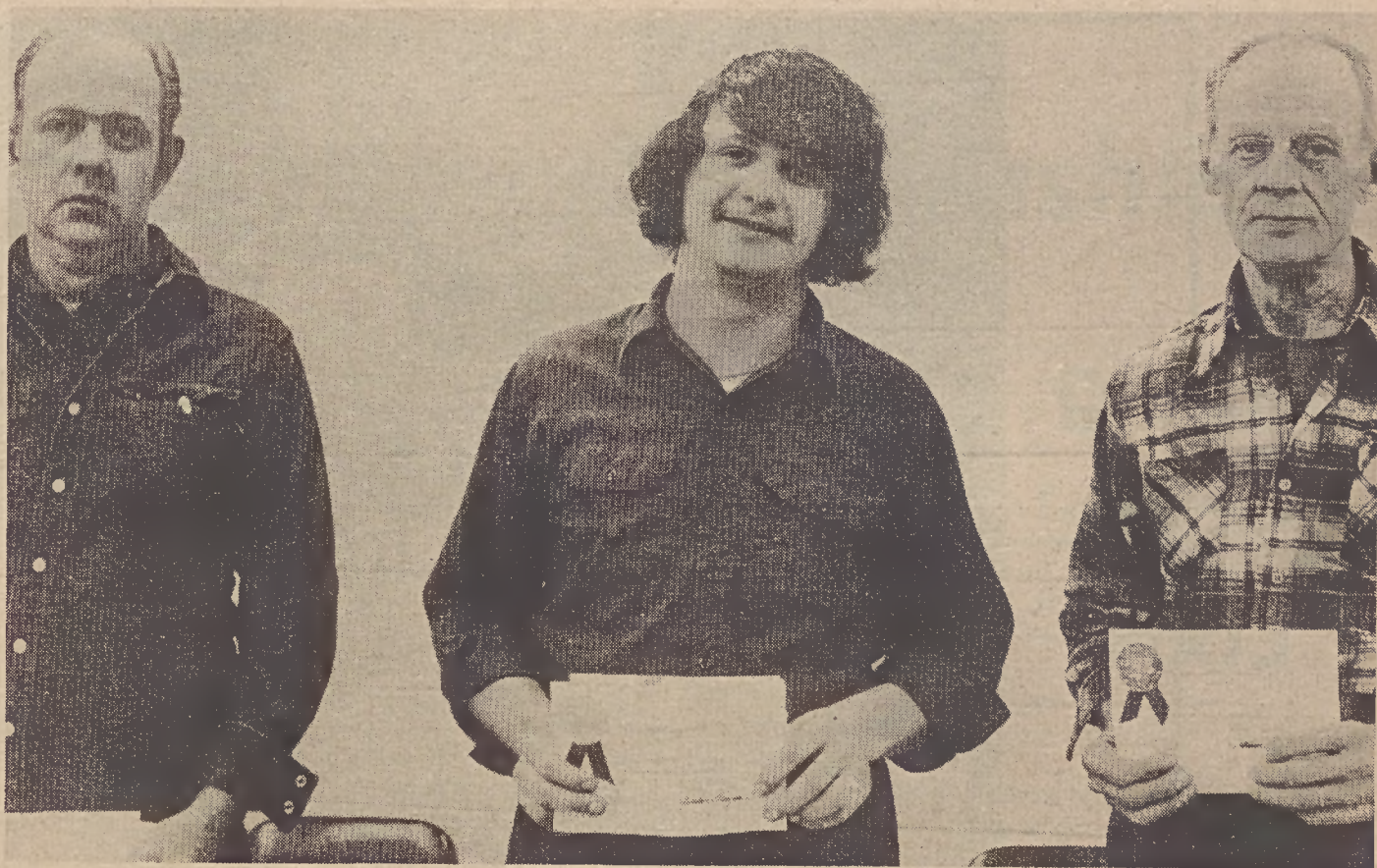
Thirty-three employees at the Bedsread Greige Mill achieved one or more years of perfect attendance on the job during 1977.

Each perfect attendance employee received a certificate.



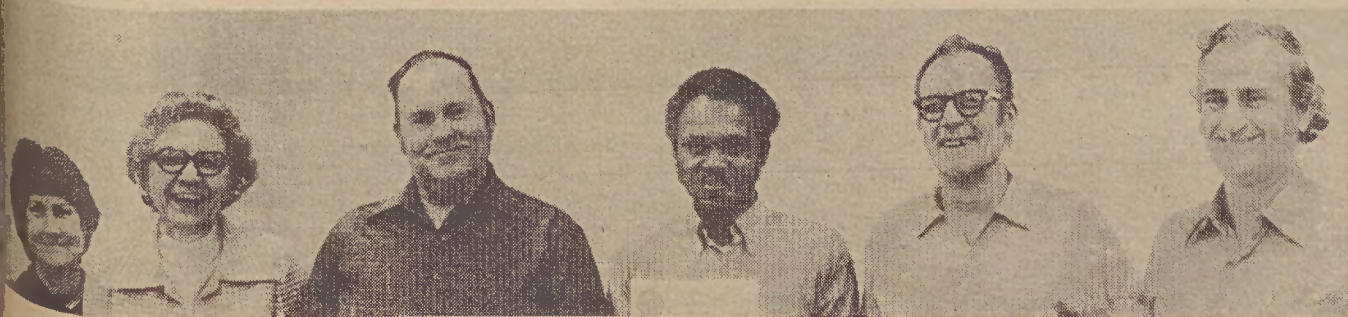
SIX YEARS—from left, Bobby Alcorn and William Carter. Five years—Raymond Hundley, at right.
