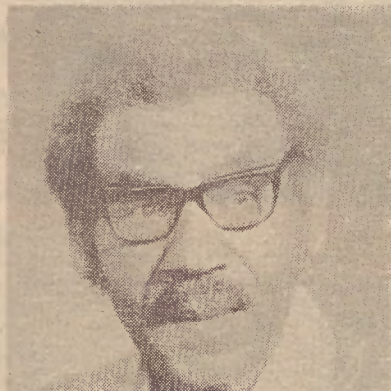

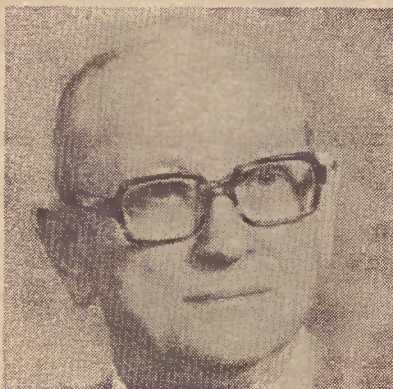

years of continuous service but first worked for the company in 1933.

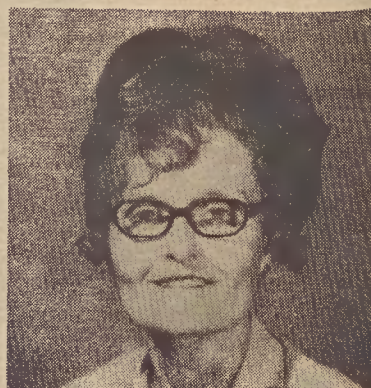
