Undoubtedly, a large percentage of you have entered the cafeteria only to exit shortly thereafter. If this happens to you and you actually happen to have some cash in your pocket (or your teller card) consider Pepper's Deli in Black Mountain. Pepper's derived it's name from the soft drink Dr. Pepper, and their two dining rooms house one of the most extensive and unusual collection of Dr. Pepper memorabilia in the world. Most of the items you see on display are of museum quality and are on permanent loan by a collector who has spent many years compiling the articles. If you are a history buff or just like old stuff, Pepper's makes for a great afternoon.

The menu includes

Sandwiches of all kinds including "Pepper's Super Sandwich" (a fresh hoagie roll bulging with sliced tender roast beef, turkey breast, juicy ham, Swiss and American cheeses - topped with onions tomatoes, and lettuce. Horseradish and hot mustard on the side), Hot pastrami, Reuben, B.L.T., Chicken Salad, and even Hot Dogs and Bar-B-Q. They also offer a Soup of the Day and homemade Chili.

If you like Deli food, you can't go wrong here. The sandwiches are made fresh for each order. It takes a little longer, but it's worth the wait. Their hours are 11:00 am to 3:00 pm Monday - Saturday. Prices range from \$1.25 for Hot Dogs to \$4.75 for the Pepper's Super Sandwich. Stop in and check em out!
