

Summer Meteorite

The second largest meteorite ever found in South Carolina is on permanent display in McKissick Museums at the University of South Carolina.

The huge "Summer" meteorite was recently purchased for \$1,000 by the Columbia Gem and Mineral Society, the USC Educational Foundation and the USC Department of Geology.

A portion of the 70.8 pound meteorite, which was found in the Peak-Lite Mountain area, will be shared with the U.S. National Meteorite Collection at the Smithsonian Institution where it will be available to scholars around the world.

The Smithsonian will polish a face on the McKissick specimen to reveal its interior structure in return for a piece of the meteorite.

The Summer Meteorite was 'rediscovered' in 1980 by several USC undergraduate geology students who heard of a "large, strange" rock, said Dr. John Ernisee, curator of the L.L. Smith Geology Museum in McKissick.

Upon the advice of a native of the Peak-Lite Mountain area, the students visited the farm of

Henry C. Summer, who showed them the metallic rock.

Later the meteorite was brought to the USC Geology Department and under the guidance of mineralogist Ed Sharpe, a fragment was removed from the specimen and sent to the Smithsonian where geologists confirmed that it was composed of 92 percent iron, about 7 percent nickel and about 1 percent cobalt and phosphorous.

Because of its size and because meteorites are rare in South Carolina, geology departments mineralogists worked with the Smithsonian curator to secure it for the university's collection. One year after its rediscovery, the meteorite is part of the "hands-on" exhibit in the L.L. Smith Geology Museum where it can be viewed as well as touched.

Scientists believe that meteorites come from the asteroid belt and represent fragments of planetary material remaining from the formation of the solar system.

It was once thought that they resulted from the disintegration of a planet, but it is now believed that they formed as small proto-planets.
