Coach Ajax Cinnamon an-nounced today that plans for a new combined football and basket-ball coliseum for this high school have been received from Washington, D. C., and that construction will get underway immediately. The Paschal, Delappe, and Powell Destruction Company has been awarded the contract and already have started grading work on the

local athletic field. This new coliseum will be the first of its kind in the nation and will have a seating capacity of over 100,000. The most remarkable thing about this structure is a convertible glass top that can be adjusted with only a push of a button. Under this system the sod for the football games will always be fresh and dry, and on rainy days the top will be raised to add to the comfort of the fans.
