For the first time since the establishment of this great institute of learning, Tee Pee High School has an eight-letter man. First Coliseum In Nation Here

Coach Ajax Cinnamon announced today that plans for a new combined football and basketball coliseum for this high school have been received from Washington, D. C., and that construction will get underway immediately. The Paschal, Delappe, and Powell Destruction Company has been awarded the contract and already have started grading work on the local athletic field.

This new coliseum will be the first of its kind in the nation and will have a seating capacity of over 100,000. The most remarkable thing about this structure is a convertible glass top that can be adjusted with only a push of a button. Under this system the sod for the football games will always be fresh and dry, and on rainy days the top will be raised to add to the comfort of the fans.

As a basketball gym it will be second to none and will have space for six separate courts. This will aid tremendously when tournament time comes around, since more than one contest can be held at the same hour.

Sleeping quarters will be available to accommodate over 500 people, and each room will be furnished with water, lights, heat, etc. A special ten-story building will be erected later on in the year. This will house 50,000 automobiles and have a landing field for airplanes on the roof.
