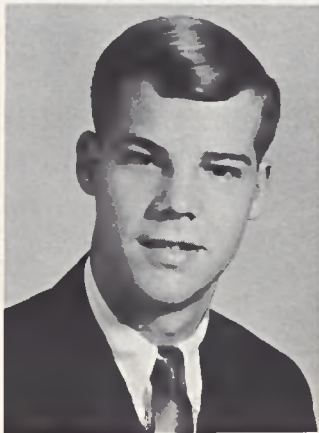

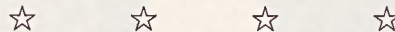
Miss Lucas, who was captain of the Albemarle Senior High basketball team this year, had already been accepted by the school of nursing and will enter in September.
