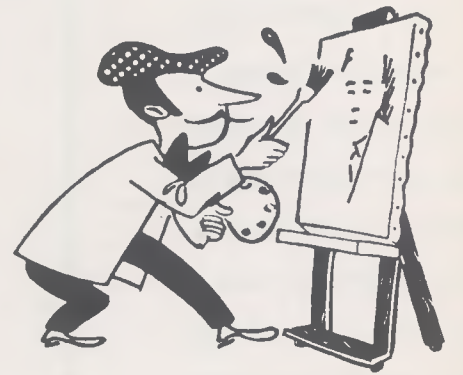
Ruth, her husband Jack and son Johnny live on the Connelly Springs road and attend Whitnel Methodist Church.
