Farmers Demanding Better Seed Stock

Tar Heel farmers are demanding and available for planting this fall. There will also be 20,000 bushels more certified seed with each passing season.

J. C. Rice, director of the N. C. Crop Improvement association, reports that each year growers of certified small grain seed exhaust their available seed supply.

During the past season, an additional 1,000 acres of certified small grain were planted to help meet the increasing demand. There were increases in the certified acreages of wheat and barley, while the amount of oats decreased because of the adverse weather.

Rice says North Carolina farmers will have approximately 55,000 bushels of Atlas 66 wheat certified

Used baskets and crates should be cleaned and disinfected as well as the walls and floor of the storage house. You may either spray or fumigate.

For houses that cannot be made air-tight, spraying with copper is best. Use one pound of copper sulfate (Bluestone) to 10 gallons of water. Spray the walls thoroughly and all containers, inside and outside. The containers may be dipped in the copper solution but spraying is less trouble.

A characteristic of an occluded Abruzzi rye to increase from 200 crin (tear gas) or sulphur for fumused at the rate of one-half pound for each one thousand cubic feet of space. Finely ground sulphur can be burned at the rate of one pound per one thousand cubic feet of space. The burning of sulphur may create a fire hazard, so take precautions.

When either fumigant is used, close the house for 24 hours and then air out well before entering.

A relatively high humidity must be maintained during fumigation in order to do an effective job. Thoroughly wet the floor and side walls 6 to 12 hours before fumiga-

Both chloropicrin and sulphur are very irritating to the respiratory passages and should not be breathed even in low concentrations. Be careful!

If you observe a nitrogen deficiency, top dress with just enough nitrogen to overcome it. Better have your county agent look over the situation with you if you are in doubt. Nitrogen deficiency is most likely to occur in the lighter sandy soils.
