

Drama became melodrama, with the inevitable villain, when Russia's unmanned space rocket entered the picture. So furtive was its mission that it breathed its last without a revelation of its intentions.

Trying to upstage the American adventure was, it seemed to us, a gamble that at best promised dubious benefit for the Soviets. Only if Apollo 11 failed did the Russians stand to profit by possibly gathering moon samples and returning


