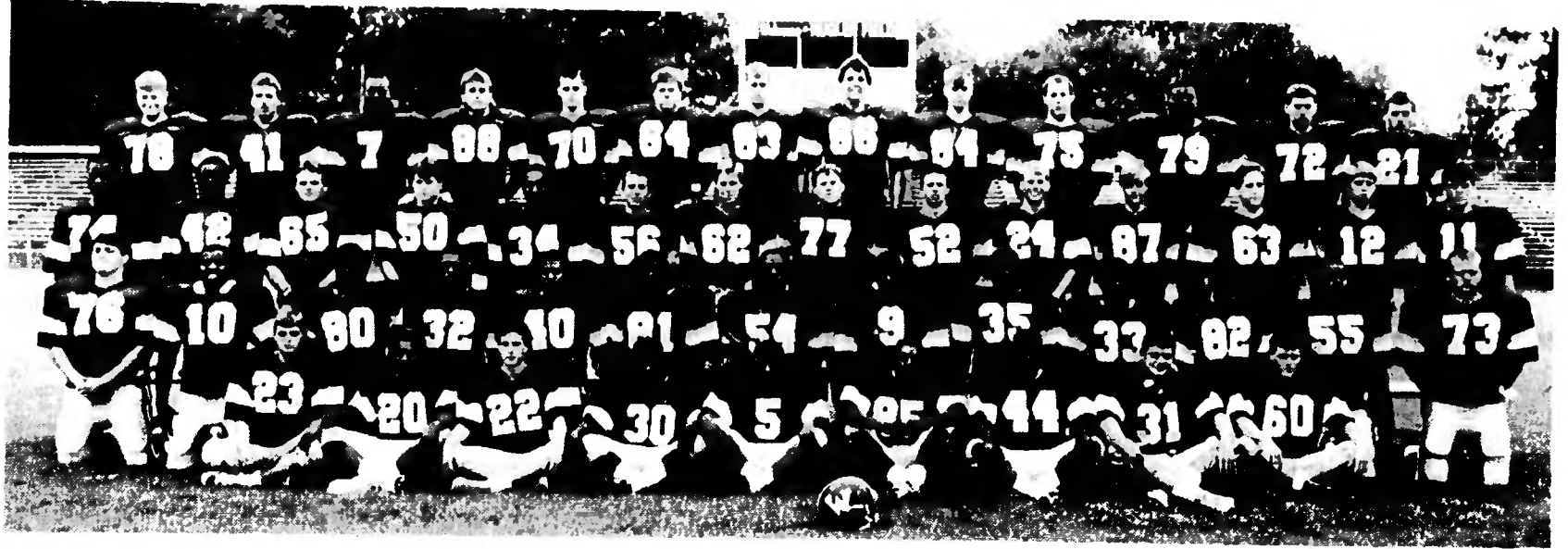

Todd Black (5-11, 143, Jr.) will replace Gerard at free safety. Backups to Littlewood at defensive end are Dale Cox (5-10, 183, Sr.), Ray Scott (6-3, 184, Jr.) and Jay Lamm (5-10, 152, Jr.). Rod Brown (5-9, 183, Sr.) will back up Jackson at nose guard while Tim Midgette (5-9, 181, Jr.) will serve as a reserve linebacker.

The corners are solid with Bryon Lyons (5-9, 154, Sr.) and Michael Laws (5-10, 152, Jr.) alter-

nating with Lodge and Tripp. Joe Ebron (5-9, 148, Jr.), Bobby Gibbs (5-8, 138, Jr.), Shane Vincent (5-6, 143, Jr.) will also see action.

The kicking game appears set with Curtis handling extra points and field goals, Manning the punting duties and Lodge the kickoff chores.

With five returning starters on offense and four on defense, Washington will start mostly juniors. Hanna said the lack of experience is the telling tale.

"A lot of the young kids are going to have to grow up real fast and that will partially determine what this team evolves into," he said. "We're progressing, and the depth has made for some pleasant but difficult coaching decisions."

"But we made them and we hope things work out."

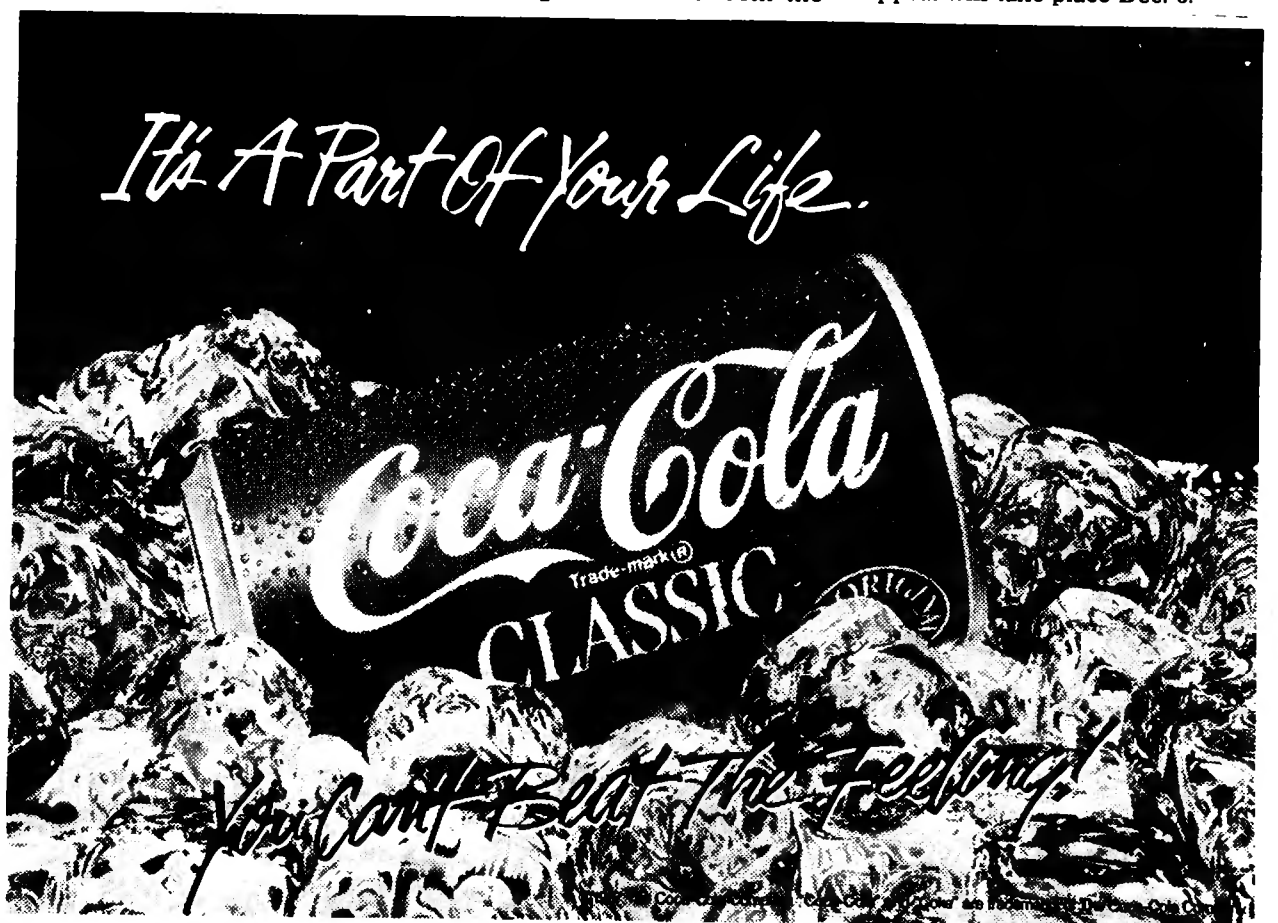
