

Greg Hollingshead Abbeyman Awarded Internship

Gregory J . Hollingshead, a junior Political Science Major Belmont Abbey at College, has been selected for a legislative internship with Representative L.A. "Skip" Bafalis of his home district, the tenth congressional district of Florida. Representative Bafalis is assigned to the powerful House Ways and Means Committee.
