

"You are the brightest, tallest, healthiest, best-looking generation of children we have seen," she said. "You are also the most free. You have the freedom to develop your own uniqueness as persons, free to find, in your own way, truth. But I caution you that when you demand freedom, please remember that you must accept boundaries and limits and involvement with others. You cannot achieve your personal freedom alone."

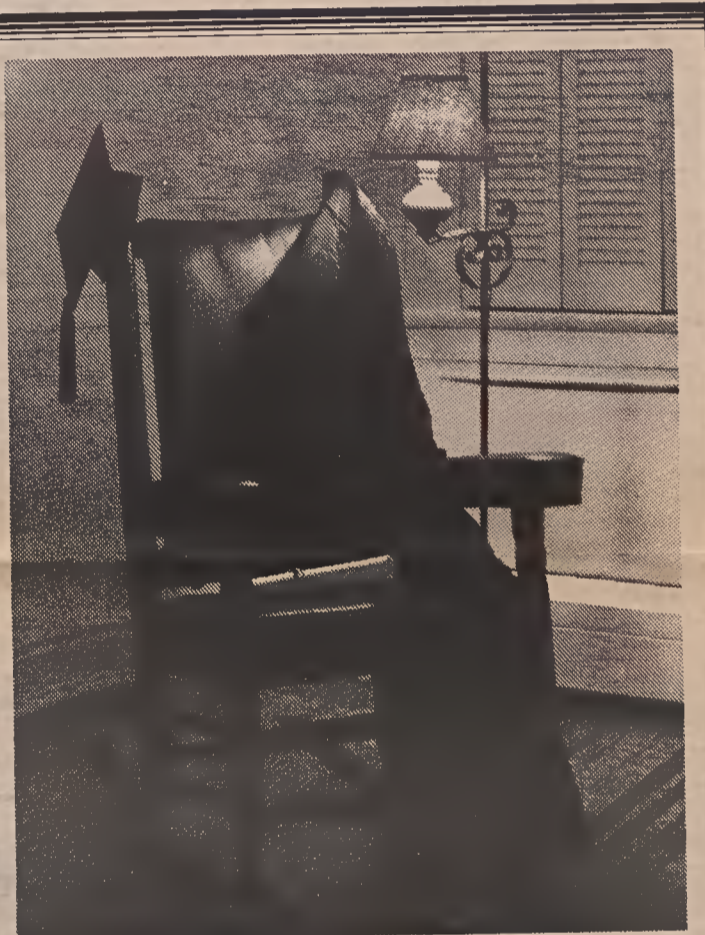
Along with their honorary degrees, Dr. Harper and Sister Jerome received a bouquet of red roses from the Belmont Abbey faculty and administrative staff.

"We decided to give them the roses because these are two special ladies we are honoring today," said Father Bradley, "and because this is a special graduation day for women who have been associated with Belmont Abbey College.
