From Player To Coach

A former B.A.C. soccer player has been chosen to head the College's 1979 soccer campaign.

John F. Murphy Jr. returns to B.A.C. from Scotland where he has been engaged the past year as a teacher, counselor, and soccer coach at Taymouth Castle School. He replaces George J. Kennedy, soccer coach at the Abbey for the past two years, and newly appointed head soccer coach at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem,

Murphy says his first objective is "to reorganize and rebuild and get a competitive team for this year." B.A.C. lost most starters off last year's 16-5 District 26 runnerup squad. Murphy estimates he has commitments at the time from about a half dozen incoming freshmen.

Murphy's soccei background includes four years of high school coaching in the Charlotte area with three years at Carmel Academy (1973-76) and one year at West Charlotte High. School (1976-77). He also played amateur soccer in the local area, and coached at the

B.A.C. summer soccer camps under Stanley Dudko, who coached the Crusaders for ten years prior to Kennedy's twoyear tenure at the College.

Last summer Murphy received the "C" certificate from the United States Soccer Federation. He will soon complete requirements for the "B" certificate with the "A" to follow in 1980.

Murphy received his bachelor's degree from the Abbey in 1969. He completed requirements for the M.Ed. degree from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte in 1977.

As head coach of the 1979 Belmont Abbey College Crusaders' soccer team, Murphy faces a tough fall schedule and the challenge of upholding the fine soccer tradition for which the school is known.
