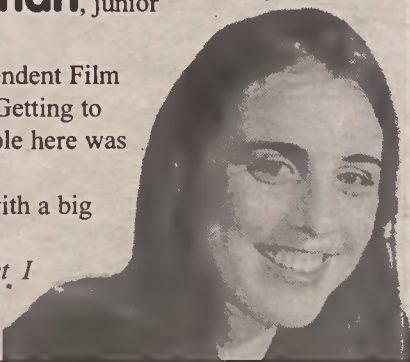

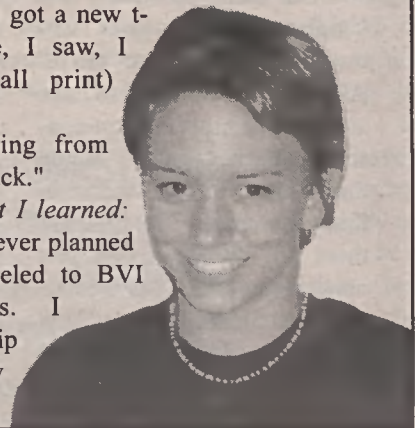
### Ashley Perryman, junior

*Most important thing that I learned:* "JELL-O does not come out of clothing."



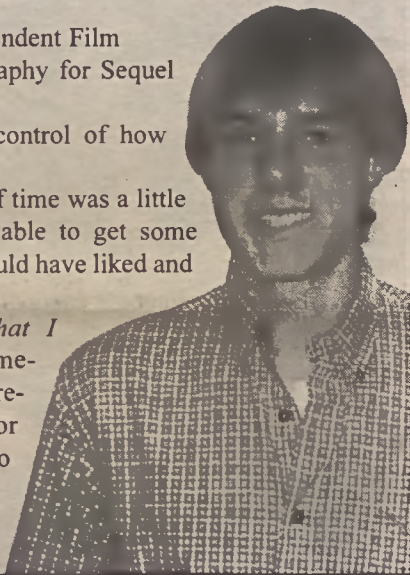
### Natasha Marcuard, senior

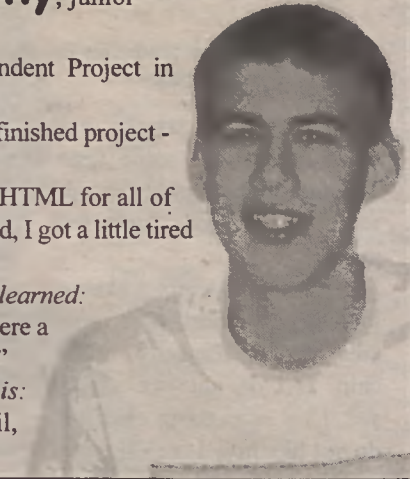


### Mary Haywood, junior

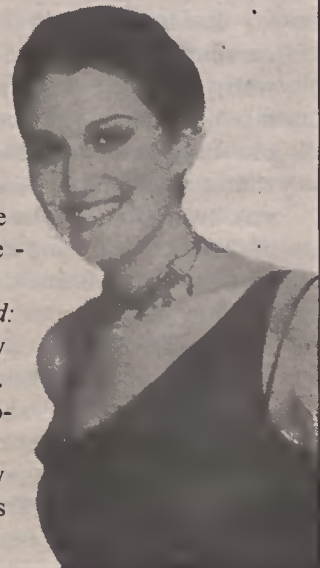
### John Abernethy, junior

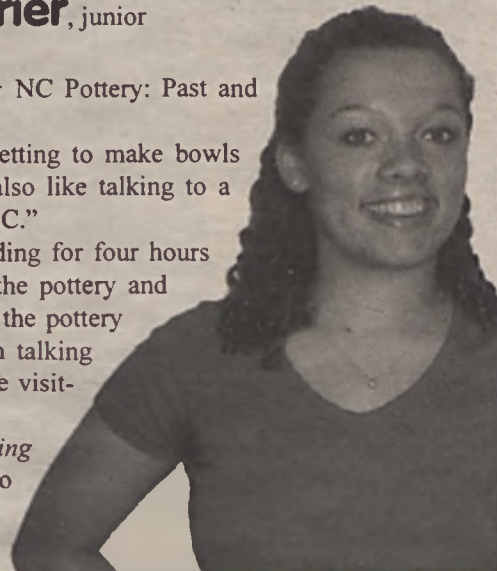
### Alexis Klein, senior

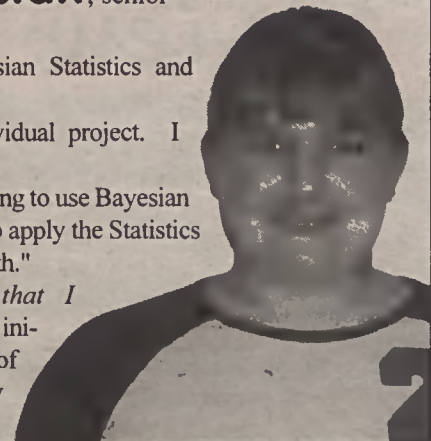
### Angel Tarrier, junior
