Edison Johnson- An indoor aquatic center where the NCSSM swim team practices. A lovely place to make some waves.

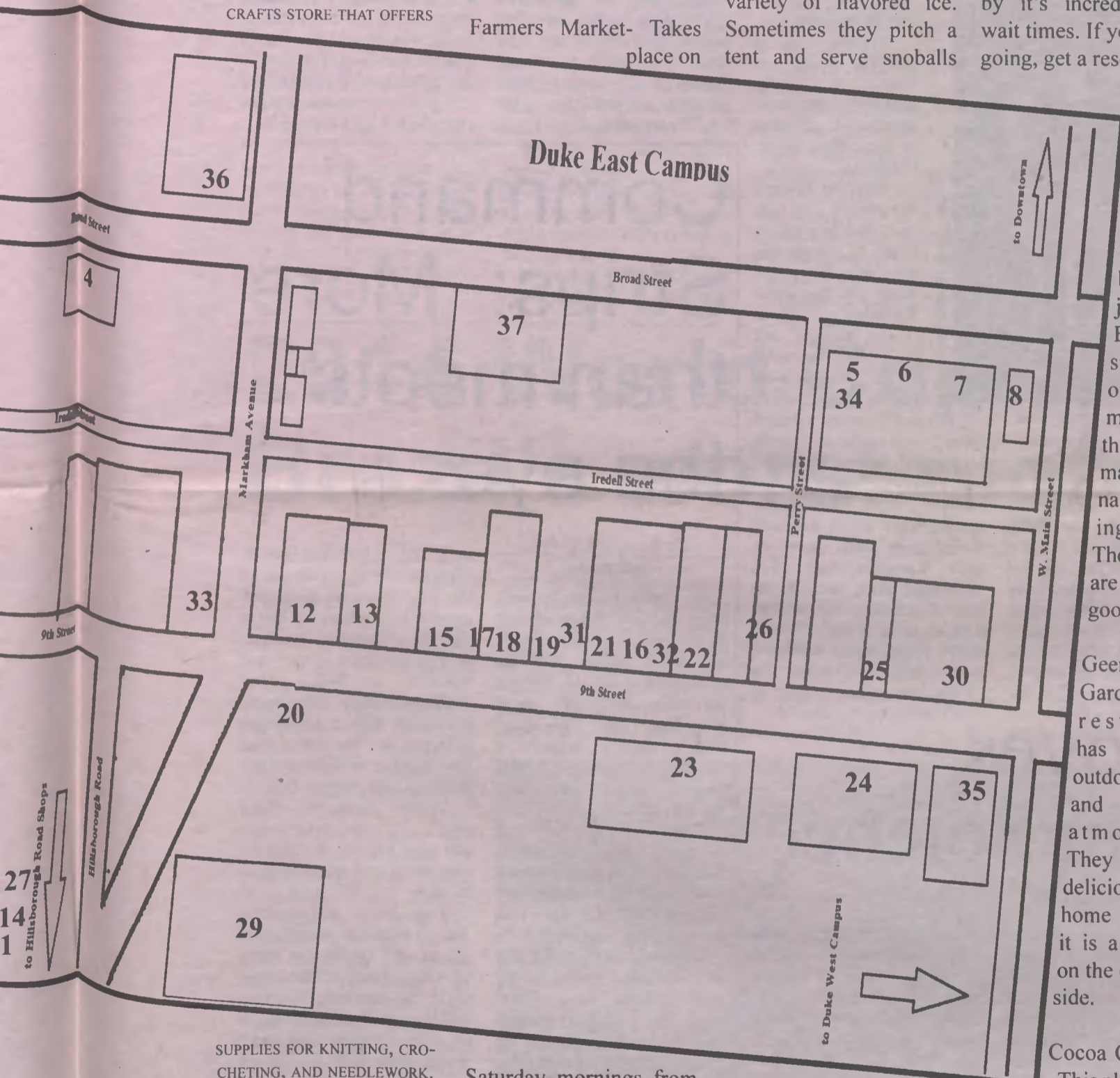
Museum of Life and Science- The location of NCSSM's prom, this museum offers a butterfly house and a zoo containing local fauna, in addition to quality museum facilities.
