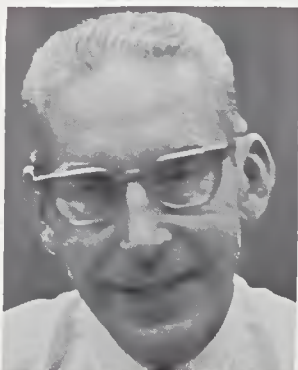

 "I try to do a good job and abide by all rules to prevent product contamination. Certain lubricants are taboo. I refrain from using these. I keep my tools clean when I go into a clean area and always wear shoe covers whenever necessary. When I work on corner rounders, I try to give an extra good job. I've spent several hours sharpening and aligning them to get a good sharp cut. Even when its not called for on a Work Order, I personally inspect moving equipment such as chains to pick up places where they might rub on guards causing metal particles to contaminate film."

 "My contribution to improved quality is to (1) insure that we have high calibre employees in the plant who are properly trained. I record any footage affected by defects so it can be separated



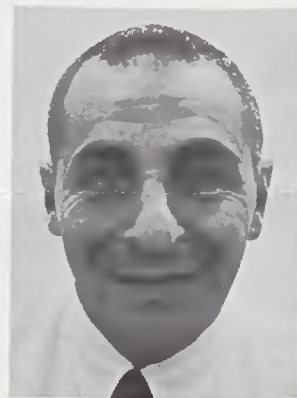
