THE COMPANY

C. B. MCCOY, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD, ISSUED A LETTER CONGRATULATING ALL DU PONT EMPLOYEES FOR A HISTORY-MAKING JUNE PERFORMANCE. THE ENTIRE COMPANY (98,669 EMPLOYEES) WORKED THE WHOLE MONTH WITHOUT SUSTAINING A LOST TIME MAJOR ON-THE-JOB INJURY.

HE ALSO MENTIONED THE SIX MONTH HISTORY-MAKING COMPANY PERFORMANCE, JANUARY THROUGH JUNE, 1972. ON-THE-JOB INJURY FREQUENCY WAS ONLY 0.12 INJURIES PER MILL-ION MANHOURS WORKED. THIS IS LESS THAN HALF THE 0.25 GOAL FOR 1972. Note: A frequency of 1.00 means one major injury per million manhours worked.

WE HAVE EXPERIENCED NO ON-THE-JOB INJURIES AND HAVE THE LOWEST OFF-THE-JOB INJURY FREQUENCY.
