Red Cross, the Arts Council, Experiment in Self-Reliance and a number of day care centers.

Also, housing complexes like Sunrise Towers cater to our Black senior citizens are knowledgeably staffed.

Nonetheless, more services need to be provided for our aged. Actual studies show that Blacks,

65 and over are among the fastest growing population categories in the nation. This means that within the next 30 years, the number of Blacks over retirement age will exceed those of working age for the first time in our history.

One area of critical concern will be how to increase the number of long term nursing homes for our Black elderly. Although there are plenty of nursing care centers in North Carolina, most are too expensive for most Blacks to afford.

During this Christmas season, let us think of the problems that plague our senior citizens and begin to think seriously about how we can ease them. It won't be long, you know, before their immediate problems will become ours.
