At present, there are two churches (Goler Memorial A.M.E. Zion Church and Union Ridge United Methodist Church) that are working with two schools (Kennedy Learning Center and Konnoak Elementary School).

Through this program, one of the most important links in the educational chain can be significantly reconnected. Once the Faith Community takes advantage of the Legal opportunity that it has, there will be a tremendous benefit for the students, the family, the school system and the future quality of all young people who are coming out of our school system.
