

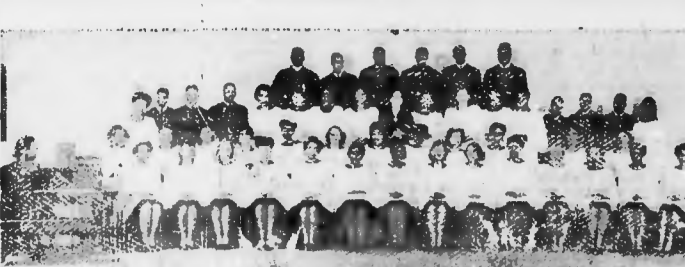
SALE OF REAL ESTATE FOR TAXES
