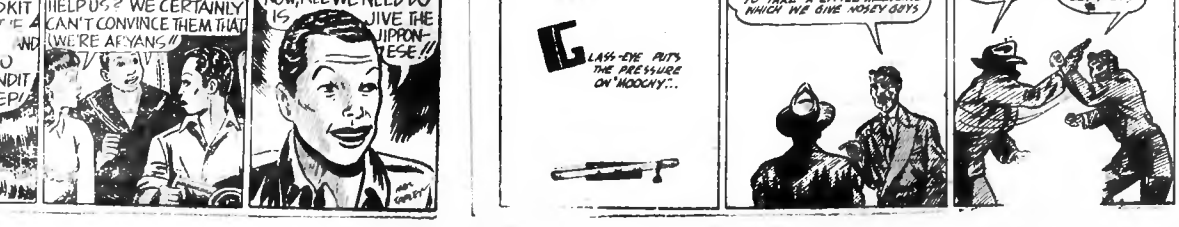

They later arrested Oth Ashford, Union member and one of the lowest clerks in the People's Butcher Shop. Only prompt action by a representative of a newspaper and Councilman Benjamin Davis wailed the police who were young white men and didn't know the explosive nature of Harlem people when they are attacked. This example of oppression shows the possibility of Negroes being denied jobs, food and equal rights after the war and must be counteracted now by organizations of vocational guidance and Fair Employment Practices Committee throughout the land so that the danger of riots will be removed.
