Bilbo ousted from the Senate of the United States. The petition, addressed to President Harry S. Truman and Members of the U. S. Senate, denounced the pro-fascist policies of America's Number One Senator and demanded that his fellow Senators expel him from their ranks.

Asserting that "Senator Theodore G. Bilbo of Mississippi daily broadcasts taunting calls to all Americans to fight Hitlerism in the Army."

31 Candidates Awarded Degrees At Shaw Finals

RALEIGH — Finals of the Shaw University Summer session were held at the institution last Friday. 31 candidates were awarded degrees. Dr. Leslie Pickney Hill, president of Pennsylvania State Teachers College, gave the commencement address.

Speaking before approximately 500 students and friends, Dr. Hill told the candidates composed mostly of experienced teachers, that teachers can have a satisfying peace when they are examples of the principles which should shape the world.

"Teachers must have judgment based upon the deepest convictions that have come down from man as asserted."

Dr. Hill was presented by President R. P. Daniel, Dean William H. Strassner of the School of Religion, the invocation, and the Reverend C. F. Pope of Raleigh pronounced the benediction. Special music was furnished by the Summer School Chorus, directed by Mrs. C. M. Thomas, and E. Reginald Swain, special guest soloist.

Warning that books have never made man come to that stage where he will have good sense, good will, Dr. Hill urged the degree recipient to seek for themselves and teach to others such simple virtues as truth, love, humility, service and beauty.

In recalling six teaching imperatives which he estimated have received the approval of 10,000 teachers of both races, he predicted a better day for all humans. The six imperatives of which he is author and which he urged be recognized by teachers are: quality of races of man, identity of human blood, the fact that the color has nothing to do with a man's worth respect for all human personality, love in man and human humanity and environment.

Awarded degrees were: Bachelor of Arts — Joseph C. Saint-Fort, one of four students studying at the institution from St. Marc, Haiti; A Fascist Criminal is a Member of the United States Senate.
