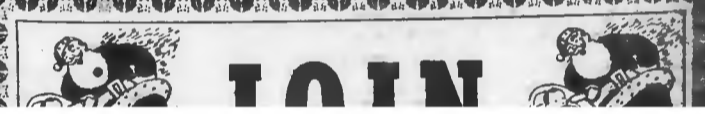

Ex-Slave Who Predicted Outcome Of World War II, Dies At 104

NKX BERN (ANP) — Mrs. Della Parker, 104-year-old ex-slave who predicted Hitler's defeat, died here last week just before she reached her 105th birthday.

Lord and pray hard. Be obedient to the Master's commands, and He will lengthen your days and keep you well and happy."

She was a slave of Joe Laughlin, a house of Pitt County when the Civil War occurred and remembered the "bigballs flying through the air, tearing down area, she moved to James City, across Trent River from here, with other slaves.

She attended a school, operated by northern white women, during the Civil War and learned to read, but did not learn to write. The Bible was her favorite book.
