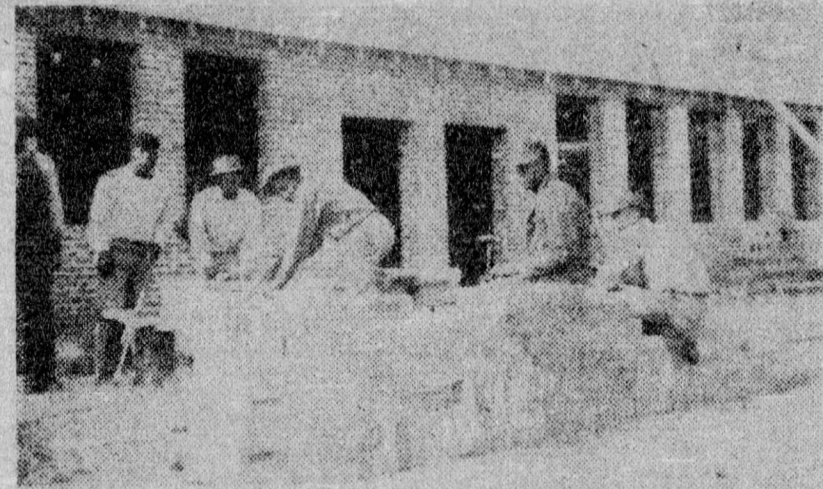

Make Your Own Oatmeal Cookie Mix



Traditionally, the holiday cookie jar should never be empty.

Easy to use, you can make this mix in just 20 minutes, then store it on the pantry shelf.

For a special holiday touch, sprinkle shaved Brazil nuts over the cookies before baking.

Oatmeal Cookie Mix Makes 8 dozen cookies

2 3/4 cups sifted flour, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 2 teaspoons salt, 2 1/2 cups Oatmeal Cookie Mix, 1 egg, 1/2 cup sugar, 1 cup shortening, 3 cups rolled oats (quick or old fashioned, uncooked).

To make 2 dozen cookies: 1/2 cup Oatmeal Cookie Mix, 1 egg, 1/4 cup sugar, 1/4 cup shortening, 1/2 cup rolled oats, 1/2 cup flour.

Variations: Add 1/2 cup chopped nuts, raisins, coconut, or chocolate chips to prepared batter.
