SOUTH AFRICA

The native Zulu population reported to primitive means in bringing into actuality a desire that has been felt by the natives for decades since their country was first "invaded" by persons of other nationalities.

Durban, itself, is a city over which hangs a pall. Many homes have been razed by fire and others have been vandalized. More than 1,200 natives and Indians have been treated at hospitals for major ailments following the riot, whereas more than 5,000 have been treated in minor cases.

An estimated 25,000 Indians are now being housed in refugee camps in and around the city creating a problem of sanitation, food and water.

The natives in the territory have given notice that they will no longer tolerate the over-running of their land by "outsiders" who control upwards to 99 percent of the commerce of the region.
