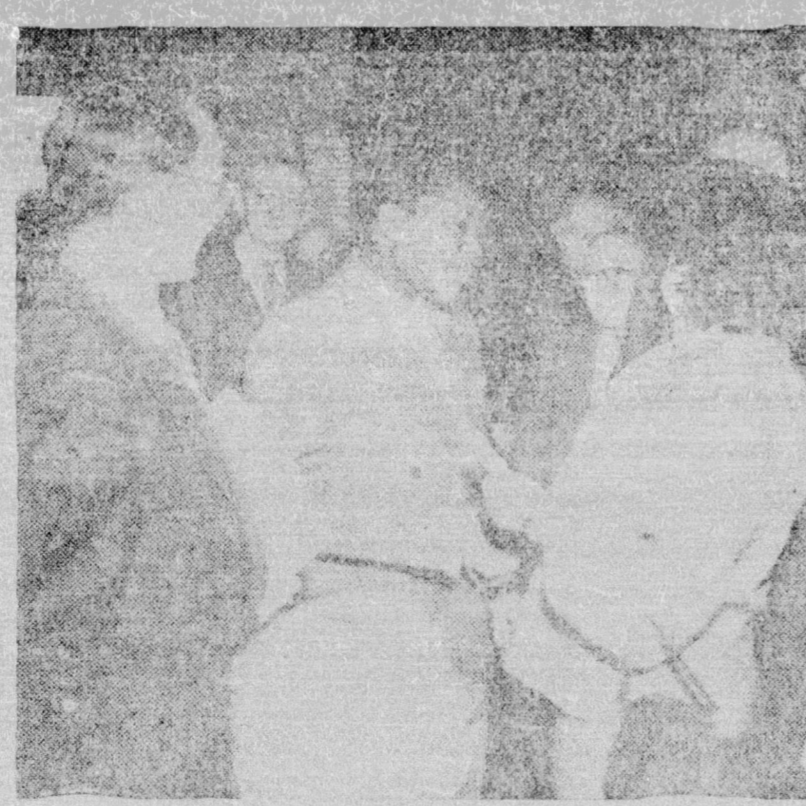

Sunday Supper



For your next informal Sunday night gathering, try tender and delicious Corn Meal Biscuits topped with tangy ketchup. Garnish each serving with crisp bacon and sprinkle paprika across the top as a color accent. The favorite flavor combination of corn meal and cheese meet here in a new serving idea that your guests will love.

Corn Meal Biscuits 1 1/2 cups sifted enriched flour 1/2 cup enriched corn meal 2 teaspoons baking powder 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 cup shortening 1/2 cup milk. Sift together dry ingredients. Cut in shortening until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add milk, mixing lightly until mixture is dampened. Turn out on lightly floured board and knead gently a few seconds. Roll out to 3/8 inch thickness; cut with floured biscuit cutter. Bake on ungreased baking sheet in hot oven (450 F.) 12 to 14 minutes. Split each biscuit. Place Welsh ketchup between halves and over top. Sprinkle with paprika and garnish with half strips of cooked bacon. Serve immediately. Makes 6 servings.

First To Play All Records Automatically



Jackie Van, recording songstress with Al Trace's orchestra, finds it hard to believe that this new Admiral table model radio-phonograph will automatically play with one tone arm all six of the types and sizes of phonograph records she is holding. Called the "Triple-Play," the new changer is the first in the industry capable of automatically playing every disc, both the new long-playing and the old standard, at all the turntable speeds—78, 45 and 33 1/2 rpm—allowing up to four hours of uninterrupted recorded music from Beethoven to boogie-woogie, and even the old Caruso and John McCormack recordings of yesterday. The new record changer is expected to bring standardization to the phonograph industry and eliminate the confusion existing today.

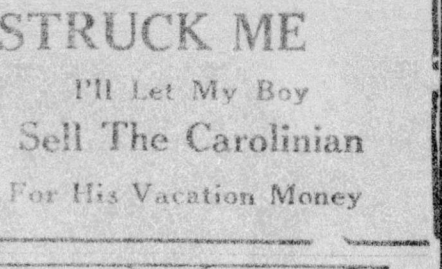
