HENRY WALLACE RAPS CONGRESS FOR FEPC DELAY

Washington, D. C. — Progressive Party leader Henry A. Wallace, decided this week that "if the Congress should fail to pass FEPC, the Progressive Party will not let the matter rest."

"You may put these bills out of sight, but we will keep them on our minds and millions of Americans of all colors and creeds will help us do just that," he said in a statement presented to the Power Subcommittee of the House Committee on Education and Labor, now conducting hearings on FEPC bills.

The former vice president charged that the "handful of men" who profit from inequality are perpetuating Jim Crow with the aid of leaders of both Democratic and Republican parties.

Wallace pointed out that when the Republicans controlled Congress they failed to pass an FEPC and that now that the Democrats are in control an equal number of Democrats joined the Republicans in perpetuating the filibuster against FEPC.

"These senators would not be so bold in foisting the human rights of 15 million Americans if the President of the United States were not a party to their game," Wallace charged. Wallace said that President Truman's failure to end Jim Crow in the Army and in the Panama Canal Zone and his failure to direct the Justice Department to protect the civil rights of Mrs. Rosa Ingram, the Nixons, the Mallards, and the Trantons has given the green light to Senate and Congressional enemies of F. D. R.

Tallahassee, Fla. — The 188 members of the graduating class of the Florida Episcopal Theological School, held an inspiring breakfast service here for the Rev. Frank Z. Bishop, Bishop of the Diocese of Florida, the Episcopal Church of Jacksonville, on the last day of their convocation here. He urged them to become sons of God and to take their place in the world as men of God.

3rd GI Gets Death in Guam Murder

GUAM — S-Sgt. Robert Burns, 21, of Spokane, Washington, was found guilty and sentenced to death following 15 minutes of deliberation by a court martial in connection with the rape-slaying last January of Miss Ruth Farnsworth, a Navy Department civilian employee on the island of Guam.

Burns was convicted following a three-day trial. He is the third of the GI's to be sentenced to the death penalty in connection with the crime. The other two are Pvt. Joseph and Calvin Dene, half-brothers of Calvert and Segall, respectively.

Sentences are subject to review by the War Department officials before they are carried out.

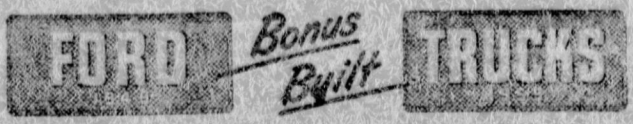
