Tables Go Modern Yet Retain Beauty

Tops among the latest furniture fashions are the new versions of traditional style tables which incorporate the functional features of modern furniture but still retain their "Old World" beauty.

SLIDING TRAYS

Ingenious designs have reproduced the masterpieces of Chipendale, Sheraton, Duncan Phyfe, and other noted 18th Century craftsmen—but have added such modern conveniences as removable sliding trays faced with brass, copper, or cork to make them impervious to water rings, cigarette burns, and other stains—drawers with bullet-proof coasters to accommodate cocktail glasses—slop tanks with an opening in back so radio cards can be dropped through instead of draped across the table brackets.

FOLDING TOPS

Other new designs include cocktail tables with folding tops which are easily flipped open to double the size. Some of these are lined with copper so that when the top is opened for party-use the copper side is exposed and no damage can be done to the outside wood or laminate surface. There are also large, handsome "Hostess" and "Hospitality" drop leaf tables—some of cocktail height, others of dining height—which are easily converted to a handy serving table by closing the leaves.

GAME TABLES

For bridge, chess or checker enthusiasts, there are elegant traditional tables in both 18th Century and French Provincial styles which open up to bridge size and reveal chess or checker board inside tops.

ROOM PLANNING HINTS OFFERED

When planning the furniture arrangement of a room, there are several basic principles to remember which will guide you in the right direction.

One of the first points to consider is balance, which means the proper distribution of weight and the best possible use of space. To achieve the proper distribution of weight, place the heavy pieces as far away from each other as possible. If all the heavy pieces are on one side, the room takes on a lop-sided appearance.

Never furnish a room with all large pieces as this will result in an overcrowded room and one that is difficult for people to get around.

Arrange your important pieces such as sofas, chairs, console radios, or television, large chests, or desks parallel with or at right angles to the wall. Never cut off the corner of a room by placing a large piece only-cornered.

If you have a sofa on one wall, balance it with an important piece of grouping such as two armchairs with a table between them on the opposite wall.

Arrange the furniture so that several people may enter on a conversation without shouting.

If you have a fireplace, plan a grouping in front of it by flanking it with two chairs and a coffee table between them, or a loveseat on one side and a chair on the other.

Make the most of your windows by arranging a group of two chairs with a large lamp table between them, or you might fill that space with a decorative pierment centerpiece set.

Place your main sitting pieces so that the person sitting in them will have adequate reading light and a table within reach for smoking accessories, refreshments, etc.

Keep an open traffic-line to the doorway so that it isn't necessary for one to run an obstacle race to enter or leave the room.

HIDDEN QUALITY IS LIFE FACTOR IN UPHOLSTERY

When you're buying upholstered furniture there are hidden qualities which you should know as they affect both the durability and comfort of a chair or sofa. There are five important points to consider in an upholstered piece—the frame—springs—spring supports—fillings and the upholstery fabric.

FIRST: A good frame is made of one of the hardwoods, usually ash, maple, birch, or gunwood. Joints are double-dowled and corners reinforced with dowels and corner blocks.

SECOND: Springs are of two types—single or double and should be firmly sewed to the interlaced webbing at the bottom of the piece. They are hand-tied at the top with heavy twine either eight ways or four ways and fastened to the frame. In the more expensive furniture, the springs are always tied eight ways as this insures the springs remaining upright. A layer of burlap covers the springs and is tucked to the frame. Both spring seats and backs are found in the better upholstered pieces.

THREE: Spring supports should be made of interlaced webbing and tightly fastened to the frame so that they can stand long wear before sagging.

FOUR: The filling is usually of moss, or hair, or a combination of both, and in the higher grade upholstered furniture the loose seat and back cushions are filled with a mixture of down feathers and hair, or silk down. Hair retains its resiliency longer than any other type of filling but moss is less expensive and will give satisfactory wear for many years. Down cushions are, of course, the softest but have to be fluffed up constantly to keep them in shape. Foam rubber is the newest type of upholstery material and is rapidly becoming more widely used. It is extremely resilient and retains this characteristic practically forever. In some pieces, foam rubber upholsterer is used without a spring base while in others, a thin layer of foam rubber is used over a spring base. Due to the high cost of this material, foam rubber upholstered pieces are found in the upper price brackets.

FIVE: The quality of the fabric or sofa cover should be important to consider. The length, width, and height will be of course of prime importance in determining the standing of style in selecting upholstered furniture and ease and cushioning which give the general dependability upon the price piece firm and firmness.



The increasing popularity of Modern furniture can be attributed to the newer style trend which substitutes gentle curves and graceful proportions for the straight, boxy look of the earlier designs. Note that while the pieces shown in this living room grouping are free of ornate, dust-causing carvings, the straight lines are softened with slight curves, and that the bases of the sofa and chairs are raised to lend them a lighter feeling. The soft, buttery finish of the wood is another important new style feature.

Casters Again Used On New Furniture

It's good news to homemakers that good-looking casters are once again appearing on all types of furniture. Their re-appearance is partially due to the advent of home television and portability, because manufacturers have realized their convenience to the home maker. In most cases, the new casters, made of brass or hard rubber, are smaller and less conspicuous than they were in the old days.

You'll see the casters on both traditional and modern styles, and on unshielded chairs and sofas as well as on beds, tables, chests, etc., of the piece. An inexpensive chair will not be covered with the same quality fabric as an expensive one. However, the price does not always determine the wearing quality of upholstery fabrics as some of the finer ones will not wear as well as a coarser, heavier fabric. The better designs, textures, and colors, as well as the pure silk, woods, and blues are used on the pieces of better quality.

MIRRORS LEND ROOM SPARKLE

With the trend to modern interiors, mirrors have gained in popularity as decorative wall treatments, and when used properly, add great charm to a room. Mirrors are also an effective way of creating atmosphere of space and light, so are often used in a small living room over a sofa or mantel to make the room appear larger in a dark entrance hall to brighten it up.

Mirrors generally fall into two classifications—framed and unframed. The large unframed are preferred for modern rooms or for the room that combines both modern and traditional furnishings. For the 18th Century or Provincial room, framed mirrors are recommended with handsomely carved frames of mahogany or gold-leaf, as well as a coarser, heavier fabric. The better designs, textures, and colors, as well as the pure silk, woods, and blues are used on the American or French Provincial.

When selecting a mirror, it is important to consider the length, width, and height which will be out of scale with the wall on which you plan to hang it, and also the size of the picture which hangs in front of it. 


