1200 Thrill To Carols As Presented By A&T Choir

GREENSBORO — The 75-voiced A and T College Choir, under the direction of Howard T. Pearall, head of the music department, was warmly received by a capacity audience of some 1200 persons in the annual Christmas Carol Concert held at the college Sunday evening, December 14. It was one of the major appearances of the group for the winter season.

The Christmas portion of Handel's "Messiah", including "And the Glory of God", "Glory to God", "He Shall Feed His Flock Like A Shepherd", "Behold the Lamb of God" and "Hallelujah" was the featured rendition of the evening.

A first group of selections by famous composers featured: "To The Alone Be Glory" by Bach; "Kyrie Eleison" by Richter; "White Shepherds Watched Their

Flocks", by Praetorius; "Benedicite" and "Let All the Nations Praise the Lord", by Liebering-Hogard.

Other outstanding numbers included: "Wasn't That A Mighty Day" and "Go Tell It on the Mountain", both arrangements by Work; and "Shepherds Story" by Dickinson.

The audience and the college symphony band joined in with the choir to sing three traditional carols, "The First Noel", "Silent Night" and "Joy to the World".

Rev. Cleeve M. McCoy, director of religious education at the college, read the scripture and offered prayer. Mr. Pearall was assisted by Miss Rosemond Satterwhite, at the piano and Miss Yvonne Porter at the organ console, both of the college music staff. The band was under the supervision of Walter F. Carlson, director of bands at the college.

Later in the evening the choir appeared in a guest performance before the membership of the Greensboro Country Club by special invitation. The program marked the conclusion of the official Christmas celebration on the campus which began early Sunday morning with the annual religious services at which time a special musical program was also arranged.
