1200 Thrill To Carols As Presented By A&T Choir

GREENSBORO — The 75-voiced A and T College Choir, under the direction of Howard T. Pearall, head of the music department, was warmly received by a capacity audience of some 1200 persons in the annual Christmas Carol Concert held at the college Sunday evening, December 14. It was one of the major appearances of the group for the winter season.

The Christmas portion of Handel's "Messiah," including, "And the Glory of God," "Glory to God," "We Shall Feed His Flock Like A Shepherd," "Behold the Lamb of God" and "Hallelujah" was the featured rendition of the evening.

A first group of selections by famous composers featured: "To Thee Alone Be Glory," by Bach; "Karie Eleison," by Richter; "While Shepherds Watched Their

Flocks," by Praetorius; "Biedermeier" and "Let All the Nations Praise the Lord," by Liebestreu-Hogard.

Other outstanding numbers included: "Wasn't That A Mighty Day" and "Go Tell It on the Mountain"; both arrangements by Work; and "Shepherds' Story" by Dickinson.

The audience and the college symphony band joined in with the choir to sing three traditional carols, "We Three Kings," "Silent Night" and "Joy to the World."
