





... ON MARCH 6, 1857, JUST OVER 100 YEARS AGO. IN 1834-SCOTT AND HIS WIFE, (SLAVES), WERE TAKEN FROM MO. TO ILL - ON HIS RETURN TO MO. SCOTT SUED FOR HIS FREEDOM ON THE GROUNDS THAT RESIDENCE NORTH OF THE LINE IN THE MISSOU-RI COMPROMISE ACT OF 1830 MADE HIM FREE / HIS OWNER APPEALED TO STATE SUPREME COURT & WON.

WHEN SCOTT WAS SOLD TO A N.Y. STATE HE SUED IN FEDERAL COURT 8 APPEALED TO THE SUPREME COURT IN 1856—THEY RULED THAT A SLAVE HAD NO LEGAL RIGHT TO SUE IN A FEDERAL COURT, BUT THIS FAMOUS CASE WAS THE START OF THE CENTURY-LONG LEGAL FIGHT FOR NEGRO RIGHTS, CLIMAXED BY THE SUPREME COURT ANTI-SEGREGATION DECISION OF MAY 17, 1954 /
