## Experts Reveal The Facts

Do homemakers know how much of their time is spent inhouse cleaning? According to Mamie Whisnant, Agricultural Extension Service home management specialist, the average woman spends about a third of her time cleanin; floors, dishes, clothand bath tubs.

"Time spent in cleaning can be out if all family members are trained to pick up' their personal belongings," explains Miss Whis-nant. "If they have definite jobs to do, it helps. This will save the homemaker's time and energy, and also help family members to form habits of order and cleanli-

Suitable tools and supplies are a good investment to make towards making housecleaning easier, provided they are well cared for. "They will also aid you in doing an efficient job of housecleaning," Miss Whisnant points out. "Soap, water, and clean cloths are essential materials that are available in every home. In some localities, water should be softened before using."

Miss Whisnant suggests the following list of tools needed in every home for housecleaning: brooms, brushes, mops and wringer, pails, stepladder, dust pan (long-handled dust pan saves much stooping and bending). cleaning and polishing rags, and sweeper or vacuum cleaner (de sirable).

There are a number of supplies a homemaker needs to keep on hand for cleaning. These are: soap or soap jelly, kerosene. floor wax, whiting and household ammonia. Other supplies which may be useful are washing soda, Fuller's earth, denatured alcohol, vinegar, turpentine, linseed oil. and trisodium phosphate (an ingredient in many dairy washing powders)

Miss Whisnant points out that there are many new cleaning products on the market today-products that do each job faster and better. "These products," she says, "include painted wall, woodwork, and linoleum cleaners such as foamy, scented abra-


