Summer Influx Of Southern Racists Blamed For Crosses

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Following a long lull in any outward expression of racial hatred and prejudice, a bitter outbreak of real Dixie Klan activity, directed against two local women teachers, caused wonderment and conjecture. Summed up by leaders in the study of racial problems, there is at present a heavy influx of whites, directly from the violence-torn sections of Mississippi, Alabama and Louisiana.

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa (AP) — Alan Paton, author of "Cry The Beloved Country," writing in the South African Quarterly "Africa South," predicts that there may be civil disobedience against South African whites as a result of the government's latest apartheid laws.

church apartheid would do, but would take critical action against individual persons who believe in and practice interracial and political association. For most white Christians, Mr. Paton says, mixed worship means nothing more than physical togetherness in a building called a church but association for social or political purposes implies some communication of ideas, this of course, would be dangerous to a state who believes in and practices apartheid.

The government, therefore, might overlook the mixing of races in churches and little by little arrest and imprison those who practice the other forms of association. It is impossible at this time to be quite sure what the government will do but there is no doubt that it intends to enforce its laws otherwise it will be the laughing stock of not only the Liberals in South Africa but of the world.

Just as Church leaders have openly stated that they cannot accept the exclusion of any person from the church on the grounds of race, just so other persons, some churchmen and some not, cannot accept the right of the Minister of Native Affairs to forbid political or social associations with Africans. There is no bravado about this for no one can contemplate lightly the serving of a long prison sentence. One would do it because it would be the only thing to do.

Noted Lyric Soprano: Mme. Evante In A&T Concert

GREENSBORO — One of the first of the American Negro artists to tour Europe appeared in concert at A&T College last week. Lillian Evanti, noted lyric soprano, last Wednesday, pleased a mid-day audience which nearly filled the spacious Harrison Auditorium. Her program of five parts included "Un bel di," an aria from Puccini's opera "Madama Butterfly," a number for which she has been noted over the years. This drew unusual warm applause.

The crowd pleasers, however, were three spirituals of her own composition, "Slow Me Down Lord," "Somebody Loves Me" and "I've Put My Faith in My Jesus." Her appearance was the first of the summer Lyceum series at the college.
