### 'Criticism Doesn't Hurt Me,' Ike Says

WASHINGTON— (ANP)—President Eisenhower indicated this week that he wasn't too worried about criticism hurled at him by opponents. He compared his criticisms with those heaped upon George Washington. Washington was one of the greatest statesmen ever produced by the English speaking world, said the President and if he came under heavy fire by the press during his time he (Mr. Eisenhower) need not be disturbed by the weak and inconsequential things said about him.

This observation was made when the President was reminded by a reporter that Rep. Cleveland M. Bailey, Democrat of West Virginia, referred to him with a "short and ugly" word.

The reporter was referring to a statement made following the President's press conference last week the West Virginia Representative called Mr. Eisenhower "a lousy liar". Bailey, chairman of the House subcommittee on Education which approved the school construction bill, said the President was a "lousy liar" when he disclaimed responsibility for defeat of the bill.

The President had told newsmen that he had spoken up plenty of times for the principals embodied in his school aid program. He was not too enthusiastic about the Democratic substituted bill, he conceded, but he had expressed willingness to sign it had it passed the congress. But he added he would introduce another school bill next year.

### Youth Confab Set By Mayor For November


CHICAGO (ANP) — Mayor Richard J. Daley announced Wednesday that the Mayor's Advisory Committee on Youth Welfare and the Welfare Council of Metropolitan Chicago will launch a community mobilization for youth on November 7, of all Chicago organizations concerned with youth welfare.

The mobilization will begin with a conference of more than 800 youth, community, social service, religious, civic and allied agencies. Programs and recommendations for action in solving the major problems of juvenile welfare will be developed to be carried on subsequently by the Chicago organizations and community groups represented at the conference.

"I hope and believe that this conference will develop specific recommendations for continuing action by all the people and organizations in every community," said the Mayor. "Working together, we can give our children happy and healthy lives and guide them to become responsible, constructive members of the community."
