CHICAGO (AND) — Did the baseball controversy involving Hank Aaron and St. Louis Cardinals' pitchers affect the young Milwaukee outfielder's hitting?

The record speaks for itself on Aaron's batting. It failed sharply after he had a bitter exchange with the Cardinals. Aaron accused the Cardinals' hurlers, particularly Sam Jones, and pitcher Jackson of deliberately throwing at him.

It is standard procedure for the accused to deny such charges. Led by Manager Freddie Fitzsimmons, the Cardinals indignantly resented the charges and in turn declared that Aaron was acting "boastful." Jones invited him out to a ball game.

Meanwhile, Hank's batting average slumped about 10 points in less than a week. He dropped back to .329 in the National League batting race, while his chief rival Stan Musial of the St. Louis Cardinals climbed to a commanding lead. His mark as of Thursday last was .412.

Continuing in the contention, however, were Willie Mays of the New York Giants, and Frank Robinson of the Cincinnati Redlegs. Willie was hitting .332, while Robinson had a .327 mark.

In the American League, Henry Simpson put a slightly derated New York Yankee pennant-bound team back on the path to victory.

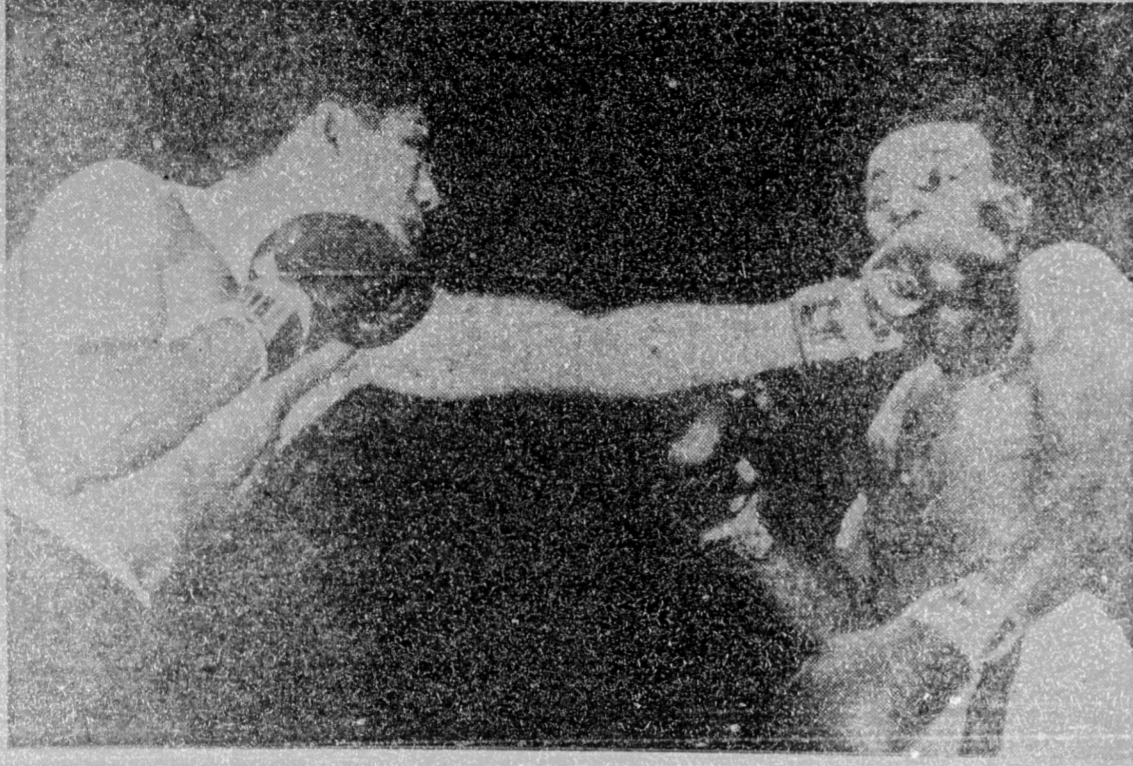
