

### Dr. John W. Turner To Lecture In Religion Dept. At Shaw U.

Dr. Grady D. Davis, dean of the School of Religion at Shaw University, has announced that Dr. John W. Turner, specialist in Jungian Psychotherapy, of Greensboro, will serve as special lecturer in the department of psychology of Religion at Shaw University for the first semester, 1957-58.

Dr. Turner will offer an orientation course in the psy-

chology of Jung by Dr. Jolani Jacobs. Jungian psychotherapy is a method for the psychic healing of those plagued by spiritual suffering from neurotic symptoms, or of those tortured by the finding of so much emptiness and so little meaning in their lives. Its purpose and objective is to help such persons to establish again or secure faith, hope, love and insight necessary for the achieving of a happy, meaningful life.

Dr. Turner holds the A. B. degree from the University of Chicago, the M. D. degree from Northwestern University. He was certified by examination as a psychiatrist by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology in 1947.

His further studies include 74 hours of didactic personal Jungian analysis by Frau Doctor Tina Keller, a pupil of Professor C. G. Jung, a student course in Modern Psychology, Summer School of European Studies under the auspices of the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology and the University of Zurich at Zurich, Switzerland.

He also attended the International Congress of Psychiatry as a member, held in Paris, France, in 1950. Other memberships include the American Psychiatric Association, American Association for the Advancement of Science, Medical Reserve Corps, 1920 to 1945 when transferred to honorary reserve as colonel. Fellow American Society of Group Psychotherapy and Psychodrama.

### Wm. Gordon Addresses MRA Group

**MACKINAC ISLAND, Mich.**—The greatest miracle in America is happening at Mackinac Island, William Gordon, City Editor of "The Atlanta Daily World," who was formerly a Niemen fellow at Harvard, told the MRA Assembly of Nations here last week. He was referring to the change MRA is bringing to human hearts.

Speaking with him were Uthia Daw, Third Nest of the Burmese Monks, Mayor of Rangoon, Burma; Ministry of Information, Mrs. Nancy Yu Hsiang, publisher of "The China Post" in Taiwan; and Guiseppe S. E. Brusasca, Member of Parliament and former Under-Secretary of Foreign Affairs in Italy.

In the audience of more than 1,000 delegates from 47 nations were 94 representatives of the China Youth Corps of Taiwan, 12 members of parliament from Thailand, and two official representatives of the Prime Minister of the Sudan.

"If America changes the whole world will be compelled to change," Mr. Gordon said. "We will have no difficulty with our foreign policy if other nations see us living absolute moral standards. I am struck by the simplicity of the MRA message. It seems to me that the simpler a thing is, the harder it is to grasp for those who do not want to change.

"There is something very genuine, very spiritual and very deep in the four absolute standards of Moral Re-Armament—honesty, purity, usefulness and love.
