

# 5 Negroes, 2 Whites Arrested In Jim Crow Seating Test

## Arlington, Va. Scene Of New Troubles

ARLINGTON, VA. (ANP)—Five Negroes and two whites were arrested here last week and charged with refusing to observe segregation in seating arrangements at a political meeting in Swanson Junior High School. All were released without bond pending a hearing. The seven were among 400 persons attending the meeting to hear Democratic and Republican candidates for the house of delegates.

Rev. Thomas Archie Robinson, 67, of Alexandria, said he and two other clergymen went to the meeting for the purpose of testing the segregation policy. Two white housewives also said they were trying to demonstrate their opposition to segregated seating at public meetings. The remaining two Negroes, a man and a woman, said they were not there "to test anything," but only to hear the speaker.

## Over 'Commie' Issue:

### Dr. Moron Lashes Back At Paper

HAMPTON, Va. — Hampton Institute's president, Dr. Alton G. Moron, lashed back at attempts by a Virginia evening daily paper to impute to him guilt by association as a result of his speaking at an integration seminar at the Highlander Folk School. The Times Herald, Newport News, Va., published reports of investigations of the Georgia Commission on Education which characterized the Montreat, Tenn., school as "a Communist training school." The story was carried prominently under four column headlines.

In an endeavor to justify the accusation against the school, the Georgia commission issued a news paper sized broadside that set forth the supposedly Communist background of a number of those at the seminar over the Labor Day weekend. Reportedly, 100,000 of these folders were printed and their mailing has been extensive — throughout the South and elsewhere. A recent Century severely criticizes a Cincinnati, Ohio, daily paper for becoming an instrument of the Georgia Commission's smear tactics.

The publication of the Georgia Commission's "disclosures" took place here last week, during the time the president was in New York City attending the semi-annual meetings of the college's board of trustees.

He answered the charges, after his return to campus, in a previously scheduled talk at the weekly vesper service.

### "Hep Cats" In Buenos Aires Almost Trample Armstrong

BUENOS AIRES, Argentina (ANP) — Ardent fans who showed up the Buenos Aires airport to greet trumpeter Louis (Satchmo) Armstrong upon his arrival here almost trampled the star in a wild burst of enthusiasm.

Armstrong arrived here early last week and received an overwhelming welcome from a near-roiling crowd of Argentine "Hep Cats" who stormed forward to meet him as he alighted from the plane. In the melee, several fist fights broke out and firemen had to use water hoses on the crowd before it was brought under control.

The incident occurred as Armstrong and his group of musicians came down the plane's ramp and the crowd broke through police and fire lines to greet them. The crowd almost knocked Armstrong to the ground in what was described as a "wild greeting."

Said Armstrong: "Somebody could have got hurt and if we get hurt we can't blow. I've had some rowdy receptions, but this one was getting a little out of hand. My back was getting tired after

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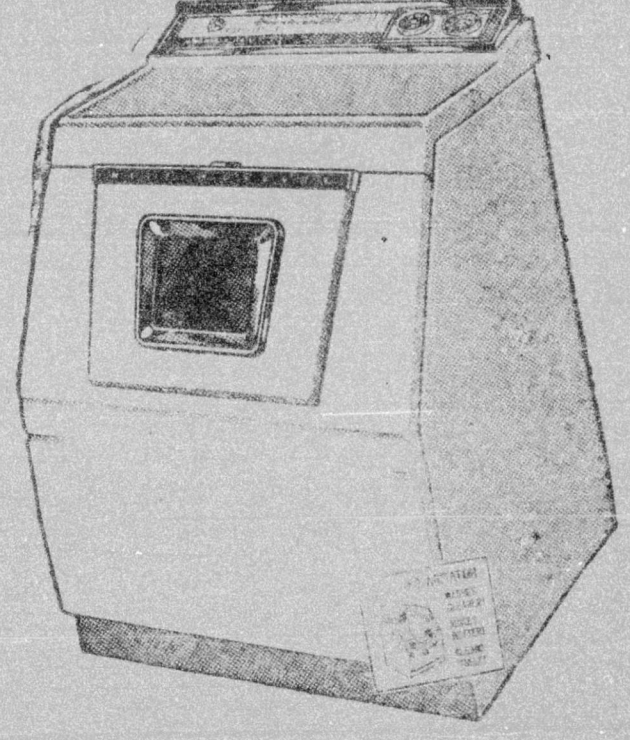

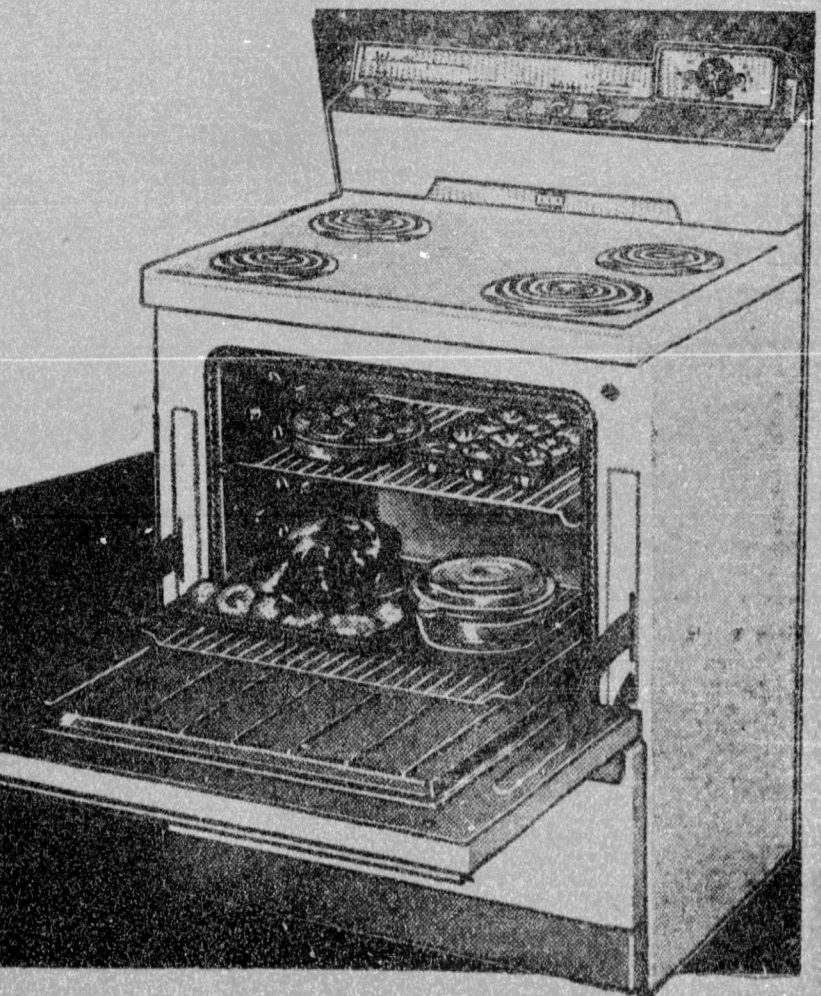
