**Interesting Words**

**QUESTION:** Can you discern in your column the origin of the words "saturate," "tip," and "tariff"?

**ANSWER:** "Saturate" is a term that means "to saturate," or "to saturate." The word "tip" is derived from "tipp," the name of a town in southern Spain. "Tariff" is derived from the Arabic word "tarik," which means "to pass" or "to cross." It was used to describe the tax levied on goods passing in or out of the Strait of Gibraltar.

The word "tip" comes from the old Chinese word "tip," which means "to tip" or "to tip." In a London tavern it was the custom to put a small box on each table and on this box was printed the words, "To insure prompt service." Those

desiring prompt service would drop a few coins in the box.

**APOSTROPHE IN O'CLOCK**

The reason an apostrophe appears between the letter "o" and the word "clock" in the expression is that originally the expression was "of the clock." For instance, instead of saying two o'clock they used to say "two of the clock." This was shortened to "two o'clock" and the apostrophe is used to indicate the omission of letters.
