

# Navy Conditions For Negroes Better, ACLU Reports

## Room For Improvement Is Seen By Investigating Body

NEW YORK CITY (AP)—Conditions for the Negro within the Navy are improving, but there is room for even more improvement.

That is the conclusion drawn in a survey made public Wednesday by the American Civil Liberties Union. The survey was conducted for the Union by Mrs. Ruth Danenbayer Wilson to review an original study done by Mrs. Wilson in 1955 for the ACLU. The results of the newest study—as with the original

—were forwarded in a letter to the Secretary of the Navy signed by ACLU executive director Patrick Murphy Mahan. These improvements were found in the past two years.

1. Negroes no longer comprise entirely the Stewards' Branch of the Navy. Some whites have been integrated into the branch. "We sincerely hope," the ACLU said, "that the number of white recruits assigned to the Stewards' Branch will continue to grow, to avoid the impression that only a few have been assigned as a token gesture and that one of the old strongholds of Navy segregation has been fully broken."

**NO ADVANCE IN STEWARDS' BRANCH**

To create further avenues for advancement for Negroes, however, the civil liberties group recommends that the Stewards' rating be consolidated with another—Cooks and Bakers, for instance—to improve chances of promotion. Generally, advancement in the Stewards' Branch, which includes a large Negro roster, is not possible, the ACLU said.

"Practically no discrimination in the pattern of life on shipboard or on Navy Bases" is currently in existence, the ACLU asserts. This shows, it claims, that "the Navy is observing the national policy of non-discrimination set down by this and previous Administrations."

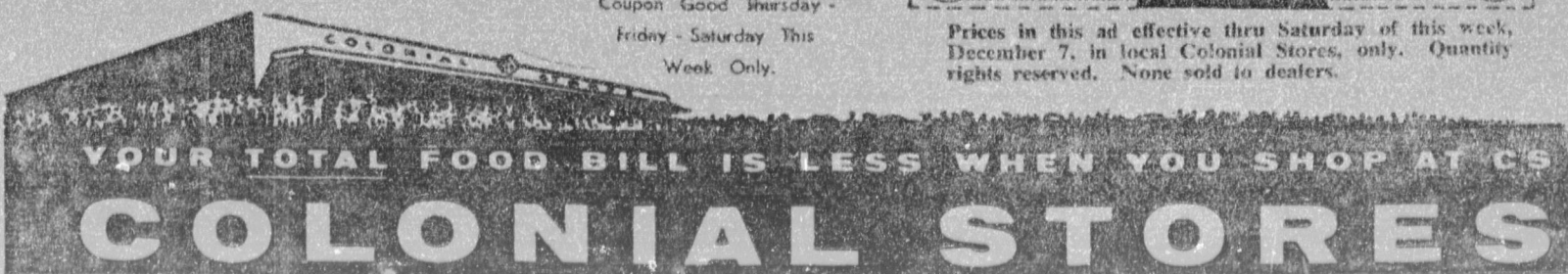
