Scala, and London's Royal Opera Covent Garden as well as at the Edinburgh Glendebourne and Holland Festivals.

The six-week institute, sponsored and financed by the National Science Foundation through a \$53,000 grant to NCC, will be held this year from June 9 through July 19.

Dr. W. H. Robinson, Director, has announced the availability of a limited number of stipends of \$450.00 for the entire 6 weeks plus \$15.00 per dependent per week up to a maximum of 4 dependents. Travel, tuition and fees will also be paid by the NSF.

Two courses each will be offered this year in mathematics, chemistry, and biology. Dr. Marjorie L. Browne, chairman of NCC's Department of Mathematics, will offer a three hour course in "Introduction to Linear Algebra." "Topics in Geometry" will be offered by Dr. W. R. Talbot, head of the Department of Mathematics

at Lincoln University, Mo. Chemistry offerings include "General Biochemistry" by Dr. Ezra L. Totton, NCC and "Inorganic Chemistry, Dr. Kelo B. Morris, Howard University.
