

provisional programme for the first anniversary of Ghana inde- a pendence have been announced by the Minister of Justice Mr. Ake Adjei, who is Chairman of the celebration committe.

The celebrations are due to open with religious services on the Sunday preceding the anniversary. There will be a mass picnic, the unveiling of the Prime Minister's statue now being erected on the lawn in front of Parliament House; a broadcast by Dr. Nkrumah and a torch light procession by voluntary and national organizations.

On the actual day March 6th, there will be a combined march past and displays by the Army, Police, Naval Volunteers Force and schools at the Sport Stadium. The Prime Minister will take the salute. Other activities for the day will be the opening of the Ghana New Agency headquarters in Ghana House, a regatta at Accra Harbour, a reception by the Governor-General at the State House.
