NEW YORK CITY (ANP)—Harlem Branch YMCA celebrated its 17th Annual Country Club and Sports Achievement Dinner Wednesday, with 300 members and friends of the club observing the find up of the greatest financial campaign in the history of the famous institution.
The diners, gathered in the main auditorium, happily applauded a trait from the shoulder talk by Detroit's Congressman, Charles C. Diggs, who pulled no punches as he lambasted the hypocrisy of the civil rights picture, warning his listeners not to be lulled into complacency by accepting the approach proposed by the shrewd proponents of segregation.

At the same time, the Congressman blueprinted a formula for achieving success in this fight, he labels "Freedom's Fight."
Earlier, Joseph E. Davis, president of Harlem's lone Negro bank, the Carver Federal Loan Association, and president of the Century Club, presented special merit awards to Miss Sara Lou Harris, Mrs. Martha McPherson, Clarence "Pugsy" Bell and Alexander Beethes for unusually outstanding work in the recent campaign.

He was followed by Jackie Robinson, now a member of the Board

of Managers of the Greater New York YMCA who made the honorable mention awards, and sports achievement awards—the first going to two outstanding athletes from the Boys Department, Albert White and Eldridge Proctor; the major awards to outstanding athletes, this year voted to Althea Gibson, U. S. Lawn Tennis Association Women's Singles Champion and to Ron Delany, Villa Nova University star runner and Olympic 1500 meter champion.
For the Youth Department, Richard A. Conyers made an excellent presentation telling what the Y means to him, a typical young member.

Va. State's Founder's Day Speaker:

"Ignorance Pushing Man Toward World Suicide," Bishop Edgar A. Love Says

PETERSBURG, Va. — The Rev. Edgar A. Love, bishop of the Diocese of Baltimore of the Methodist Episcopal Church, told an audience at Virginia State College here recently that "one great force which

is pushing man relentlessly toward world suicide is ignorance."
Dr. Love said he was not referring to ignorance in mathematics, physics, chemistry or of

ignorance of the accumulated technology which enables us to unlock nature's most secret treasures. "We are ignorant," he said, "of the fact that race and culture are merely

outward differences and that man is our fellowman wherever found.
Bishop Love was the guest speaker at Founder's Day at the College. Speaking on "The Abundant Life," the bishop said the achievement of the abundant life is not a matter of haphazard luck or of a winning gamble.
He urged his audience, composed of faculty members, students, alumni and friends of the college, to take advantage of every opportunity to achieve the abundant life, for the fu-

ture of America depends on how intelligently we Americans nourish the learning given in our colleges and universities.
The Founders Day observance began with the campus memorial at 10:30 a. m. presided over by President Robert P. Daniel. Immediately following the morning worship service at which Bishop

Love spoke, a memorial motorcade journeyed to Blandford Cemetery in Petersburg and to Evergreen Cemetery in Richmond to place wreaths on the graves of the late Albert W. Harris and the former administrative heads of the college.


