

300 Delegates Expected At Greensboro For 28th Annual Older Boys Conference

GREENSBORO — Around 300 delegates representing YMCA's and city schools throughout the state are expected to attend the 28th Annual Older Boys Conference to be held jointly at A & T College and the Hayes-Taylor YMCA, Greensboro, April 25, 26, 27. It has been announced by E. L. Paulson, YMCA executive, Raleigh, N. C.

The theme for the three day event is "Youth's Opportunities and Challenges in the Space Age" and will feature addresses by leading educators and ministers, group discussions, social and recreational features.

The keynote address will be delivered by P. J. Weaver, superintendent of city schools. He will be presented by Dr. W. H. Hampton, of the Board of Education. Rev. John Bryan, dean of the chapel, Bennett College will deliver the banquet address and Dr. M. F. Sawyer, pastor of the Trinity A. M. E. Zion church the conference sermon.

Group discussion leaders include Dean L. C. Dowdy, Dr. L. H. Robinson, Dr. S. J. Shaw, Major Fred Allen, Capt. Charles Cochran of

Recreation and social features include the YMCA championship basketball game, swimming competition, movies, the annual banquet, and annual dance at the A & T gymnasium with music by Les Nicks orchestra.

The conference will begin Friday, April 25, at the YMCA with welcoming remarks by W. A. Boldsbrough of the YMCA Board, George Cant, H-Y Club president, Josephine Boyd of the YMCA and Dr. F. A. Williams of A & T College.

Special music will be furnished by the J. B. Dudley High School band and the Lincoln Jr. High School Glee Club with Mrs. Curt Gill, directing. The invocation will be pronounced by the Rev. J. Howard Thompson, pastor of the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer.

The Auto-Fisher was developed by an expert fisherman who has spent a lifetime at the sport. His idea was that if the ordinary fisherman could set out ten times as many hooks he could catch ten times as many fish. The result was this Auto-Fisher which will catch and land fish unaided and which can also be bought at a price that will enable any fisherman to use a large number of them. It is especially fine for a family fishing party or picnic or to take the youngsters fishing.

The Auto-Fisher incorporates the fundamentals of good fishing technique. It is quiet, still, and always on the alert. When the fish takes the bait the Auto-Fisher sets the hook firmly in his mouth and proceeds to play him—ALWAYS HOLDING A TIGHT LINE! This eventually tires the fish and draws him to the surface. You get plenty of action as he fights it out! Most fish are lost by permitting slack in the line or failure to properly set the hook when the fish bites. Auto-Fisher eliminates these difficulties, will increase your catches, and save bait.

The Auto-Fisher will positively catch every kind of fresh water fish including trout and bass. Requires no aid whatsoever. Also catches many varieties of salt water fish. Makes it possible to catch fish in clear, shallow water. Note that the latch slots are arranged so that it can be set for a hard, medium or light pull. Can be fished from a point high above the water or near the surface. The spring tension can be increased or decreased and the line can be lengthened or shortened by winding or unwinding the line from the Auto-Fisher.

You will occasionally be bothered by small fish nibbling your bait and they may trip the trigger. To correct this use LARGE LIVE BAIT and larger hooks and let Auto-Fisher wait for the big ones. Of course, if you want to take the smaller fish, use small hooks and cut bait or worms. Use a simple slip knot with how to tie Auto-Fisher to limbs, etc., so that it can be detached easily. The Auto-Fisher can be fished from pole, dock, boat, limb, ice fishing.

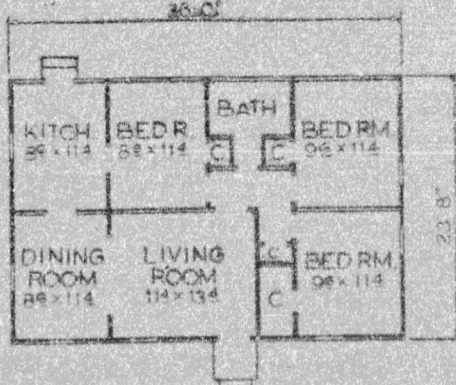
