Minnejean's Expulsion False Lincoln School Director Says

NEW YORK — (ANP) — Rumors that Minnejean Brown, 16-year-old former student at Little Rock Central High school, faces expulsion, were branded false this week by Dr. John R. Brooks, director of the New Lincoln school.

Dr. Brooks said: "We have heard

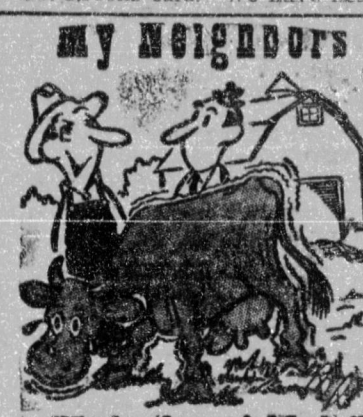
these rumors with astonishment, inasmuch as Minnejean Brown has made an excellent adjustment, is doing satisfactory work and has earned the friendship and respect of us all."

"It is astonishing to me," he added, "that this girl is able to do satisfactory work despite her impoverished academic background and the emotional impact of her prior situation and removal to New Lincoln school."

He said the faculty and the entire 433 student body—about

50 of whom are Negroes—are "delighted at way this thing has worked out, and Minnejean has made it very easy for us in the whole situation through her poise and character."

The girl entered the experimental demonstration school on Feb. 24, under a scholarship for the term ending June 3. Dr. Brooks said her future plans so far "extend only through the summer during which she plans to visit her home."

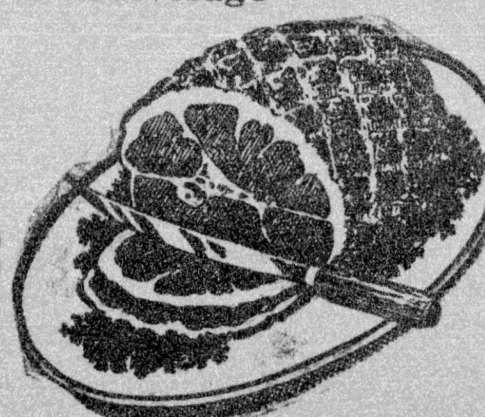
