Courses were taught in the Old Testament, New Testament, homiletics, church history, Christian doctrine and stewardship, music and worship, and organization and discipline.

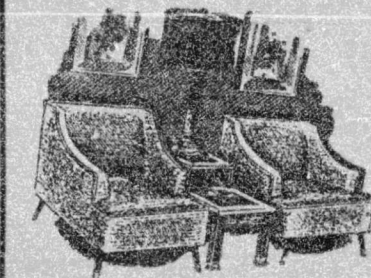

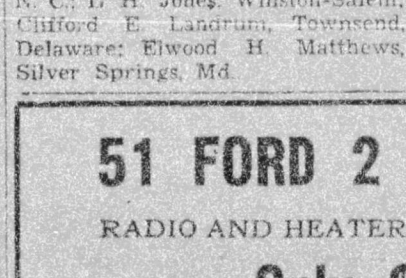
