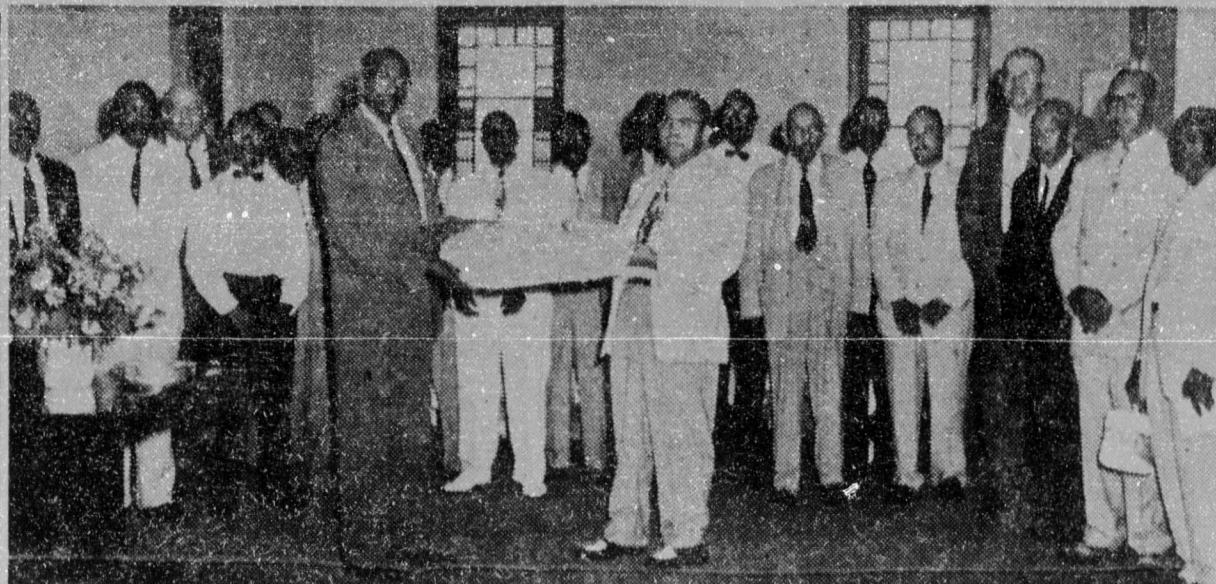

**Clinton's First Baptist Church Honors Its Departing Minister**

CLINTON — The First Baptist Church of Clinton honored its pastor Reverend J. H. Clanton of Raleigh, North Carolina for distinguished service during his pastorate last Sunday at the Regular morning worship hour by presenting him a large engraved silver tray. In his address of appreciation, Mr. Carter Jones, assistant County Agent and deacon of the church, paid Rev. Clanton a glowing tribute.

He said that the church has made tremendous progress both spiritually and physically during the almost three years of service as leader of the parish. Mr. Jones further stated that not only has the enrollment of the church increased with new baptized members, but the church has experienced intelligent leadership and a high type of worship service.

**Course in Russian To Be Taught At Bennett College**

GREENSBORO — A course in Russian will be offered for the first time at Bennett College this year. President Willa B. Player revealed this week in announcing the appointment of nine persons to the faculty and staff for the 1958-59 academic year, which begins September 10.

The course will be taught by Dr. Robert Vlach, a native of Prague, Czechoslovakia, who will also instruct in French and German. Dr. Vlach, who has studied at The Sorbonne, the University of Strasbourg and the University of Lyon, earned his doctorate at the University of Prague.

In addition to being the author of a number of books on prose and poetry and being a regular contributor to learned journals, Dr. Vlach served for a number of years as Paris correspondent for several Czech newspapers and has taught French and Russian at the University of Prague.

Another newcomer to the Bennett faculty will be Mrs. Arnieze Ramsey, a native of Winston-Salem, as an instructor in elementary and special education, succeeding Mrs. Mary T. Coleman of Reidsville, who has been granted a leave to study in these areas at Columbia

University this year. Mrs. Ramsey, a graduate of Winston-Salem Teachers' College, holds the M. A. and M. L. S. degrees from Atlanta University and is a member of Beta Phi Mu, national library honor society. She is a member of Delta Sigma Theta sorority.

Also on leave this year will be Mrs. Lydia Richards, director of the Children's House at the college, who will pursue work toward her master's degree in nursery school education. William B. LeFlore, biology instructor, on leave last year for study at the University of Southern California, has had his leave extended for another year. Returning from leave will be Miss Wilhelmina J. Gilbert, instructor in business education.

Miss Precious Copening of Cleveland, Ohio, of the class of 1945; Miss Helen Bennett of Blackshear, Georgia, of the class of 1940; Miss Clara Mauldin of Asheville, N. C., of the class of 1941; and Miss Pearl M. Whittier of Stateville, N. C., of the class of 1948.
