### State College Hints

**TO POLISH WOOD FURNITURE** — The no-rub method: Use a no-rub furniture polish, shake well, and carefully dampen a clean, lint-free pad or cloth with the polish. Wipe surface with long strokes. Then, when the polish has dried to a white haze (this takes almost no time at all), wipe off immediately with a clean, dry cloth. No rubbing will be necessary and the wood will have a bright, long-lasting finish.

**Cream Wax Way:** To clean and polish wood furniture the

cream wax way, pour a small quantity of cream wax on a clean, dry cloth, and rub over a small area of wood surface. Remove all excess wax and polish at once with a second clean dry cloth, using firm, even strokes. Overlap edges of polished areas and polish entire surface in same way.

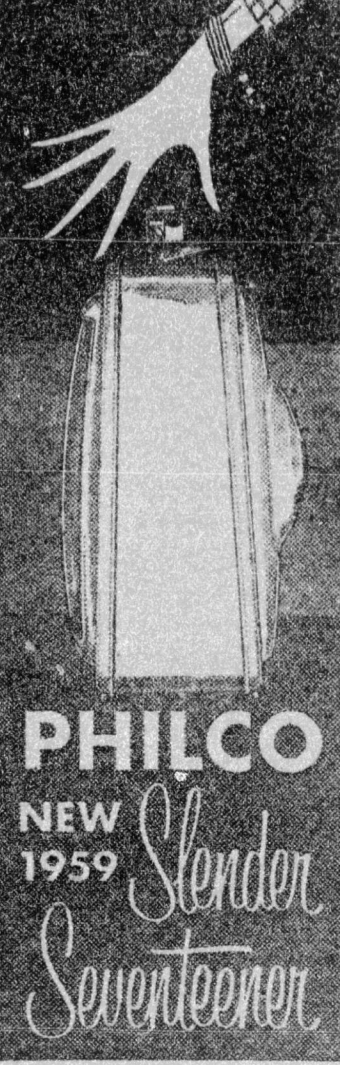
