

TO POLISH WOOD FURNI-TURE - The no-rub method: Use a no-rub furniture polish, shake well, and carefully damper a clean, lint-free pad or colth with the polish. Wipe surface with long strokes. Then, when the polish has dried to a white haze (this takes almost no time at all), wipe off immediately with a clean, dry cloth. No rubbing will be necessary and the wood will have a bright, long-lasting finish.


