Brick Alumni Reunion Held

BRICKS—The 9th annual reunion of the dwindling ranks of the Joseph Keasby Brick School and Junior College met here August 30-31 with eighty members in attendance. Registration of delegates began on Friday evening of the 29th with groups reporting from New York, Washington, D. C., Philadelphia, and the Tidewater, Virginia area. Nearby alumni reported on Saturday and Sunday.

The group has sought to keep alive the "Old Brick School Spirit" emblematic of the days of the late founder-principal — Thomas Sewell Inboden—whose memory has ennobled the institution which was once the beacon light of education for mid-eastern Tarheelia from 1895 to 1926. The junior college, added in 1924, closed about 1930.

The American Missionary Association, in cooperation with the Congregational Christian Churches, has sought to make the school plant of 1129 acres of valuable farm land and its buildings available for community service to educational and religious groups as a place of camping and various assemblies. The Rev. W. Judson King is currently director-manager of the facilities here.

Some of the proposals reported considered, but not finally approved, by the Brick alumni included propositions to donate \$200 to the school or purchasing of a water

Lt. Col. Mary Mills Delivers Commencement Address At Lincoln Hospital In "Bull City"

DURHAM — The 53rd commencement exercises of the Lincoln Hospital School of Nursing, held at historic White Rock Baptist Church here Monday evening, Sept. 8.

The address for the occasion was delivered by a graduate of Lincoln hospital, who has forged her way to the top of the nursing profession and who has become one of the most distinguished nurses of color in the United States.

She is Lt. Col. Mary L. Mills of the United States Public Health Service, formerly Chief Nurse for the United States Operations Mission to Lebanon, Miss Mills, who recently has been awarded the Ph. D. degree by New York university, also served the U. S. Health Mission in Liberia for a number of years helping to develop the nursing plant in the government hospital there.

There are 12 graduates in the class of 1936. The superintendent of the Nursing School is Mrs. Lucille Z. Williams, Wm. M. Rich is superintendent of Lincoln hospital. The Rev. Melvin C. Swann delivered the baccalaureate sermon, Sunday, Sept. 7, at Saint Joseph's AME Church.

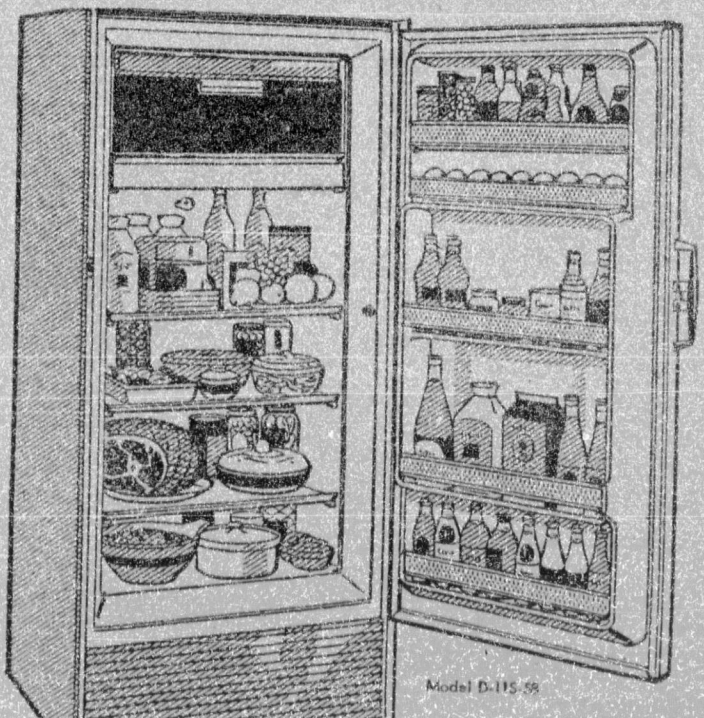
